- **ESSENTIALS OF FAITH** -- A Disciple
- Making Journey: Join Shad Mehl as he facilitates a time to explore the basics of what it means to be a Christian. The class is a video-based study by RightNow Media with Francis Chan as the first presenter. This is perfect for those who are searching, or new in their faith. Class meets in Room B111 at 6:30pm.
- PROFOUNDLY CHRISTIAN, DISTINCTLY METHODIST: Our

Methodist heritage has played a major role in impacting lives for Jesus. This class is designed to deepen your understanding of our Wesleyan doctrine and theological foundations. You are invited to join Pastor Rick and others. The study will leave you "lost in wonder, love, and praise." Workbook is found on all major book sites. Class meets in the Atrium (Room B105) at 6:30pm.

- BOOK OF DANIEL STUDY: Framework of Prophecy: The book of Daniel serves as God's blueprint for prophecy by outlining kingdoms that followed Babylon and current world kingdoms preceding the end-times, includes the "famous" 70 weeks of Daniel prophecy and detailed descriptions of the 400 year inter-testament period. 400 years before Christ, Daniel prophesied the coming Messiah; Sir R. Anderson said, "To the day." A captive in a permissive and pagan Babylonian society, yet Daniel never compromised his values, even when threatened with death. Class meets on Wednesday mornings 10-11:30am and Wednesday evenings at 6-7:30pm in Room D106 led by Linda Stephen. The study book is "The Book of Daniel, the Smart Guide to the Bible" by Duck and Richards. Cost of the book is about \$8. Have questions? Email listephen@gmail.com.
- "JESUS REVEALED IN THE END TIMES" BOOK BY DR. ROBERT JEFFRES

This women's study will focus on Jesus as the Messiah, as the Prophet, as the Lamb, as the Conqueror, as the King, as the Judge, as the Lord, and as our Friend. Most books about the end times focus on the events rather than the One who is revealed in those events. We will study the end times through the lens of Jesus Christ. *Class meets weekly on Wednesday evenings from 6 to 7:30pm in the Library.* Sign up by contacting the Church Office (316-942-1491) or Roberta (316-253-8094) so books can be ordered. Sunday, October 5th World Communion Sunday: Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of this sacred day, where believers around the world gather to break bread and share the cup. We are humbled by the diversity of Your people and the beauty of Your creation. We confess Lord that we have failed our sisters and brothers around the world, because we have not always prayed faithfully for them, and we have not always given sacrificially for their needs. Help us Holy Spirit to remember Your promises and empower us to be instruments of your grace. May this day remind us that we are already in Your Kingdom, and to serve one another with compassion. Amen.

Monday, October 6th: Prayerfully read or listen to Luke 22:14-20. Author Henri Nouwen notes that every time Jesus was at table, He went through four steps: He would take bread, bless it (give thanks), break it, and share it. If you have time, go through the Gospel accounts and note the times Jesus serves bread (include the miracle of the 5,000 and after His resurrection). What do you make of Jesus' four-step process? Why didn't Jesus just pass one loaf or piece around and let people break it off as they wanted?

Tuesday, October 7th: Prayerfully read or listen to Luke 22:19, and return to Nouwen's point of "Taken, Blessed, Broken, Shared..." He points out that first, this is what the Father did with Jesus, as HE is the Bread of Life, and now this is what Jesus does with each of us. Can you see this process in your life? How has the Lord "taken" you; "blessed" you; "broken" you; and "shared" you?

Wednesday, October 8th: Prayerfully read or listen to Deuteronomy 8:1-6. What are the key words in this passage? What is the Lord revealing about Himself? If you had to remember one thing about this passage, what would it be? Take time to pray about that one thing.

Thursday, October 9th: Prayerfully read or listen to Deuteronomy 8: 7-14. Again, note the key words in this passage, and things God is revealing about Himself. Why are there warnings in these verses? Do you think they still apply to the Church today? Why or why not? Pray through this passage, and ask the Lord to reveal Himself to you as you pray.

Friday, October 10th: Prayerfully read or listen to Deuteronomy 8:15-20. What does the Lord say He did for the people? What does He want them to remember? Can you rewrite these verses and instead, put elements of your life story in the verses? What would that look like? What is the final warning, and why is it there? What is the Lord reminding you about Himself and about you?

Saturday, October 11th: Review each of these Scriptures, topics, and questions that you have worked through this week. How does all of this resonate with you? Pray through these things as the Spirit leads you!
