PRAYER AT ASBURY | We believe what Colossians 4:2 teaches, "Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart" (NLT). Outside the Sanctuary doors is a prayer wall. Since the 1700's people have been putting written prayers in the cracks of the Western Wall in Jerusalem. The idea was simple: Leave a prayer, take a prayer. When we created the prayer wall at Asbury Church we had the same idea! Leave the prayers of your heart at the wall. Take someone else's prayer and pray over that. Then discard it knowing that God has heard the prayer! There is no need to return it, unless you feel like it needs more prayer! There's also a Bible where you can highlight or add an encouraging note to your favorite verse. Consider it a guest book of Bible verses!
