**12.600 GENERAL ISSUES**

- **Resident – West Acres**

At the last parish Council Meeting a resident from West Acres brought up various issues at his property, which Selby District Council hadn't dealt with. Selby District Council are to investigate all issues raised and deal with them accordingly.

- **Notice Board**

Parish Councillor Nicklin has arranged the new Notice Board. Clerk to send off cheque & arrange delivery of the same thereafter.

- **Defibrillator**

Parish Councillor Nicklin asked if the Parish Council would be willing to part fund a Defibrillator for the village. The Parish Council all agreed and had no problem with this. He said that he would look into suppliers and put in an Application to CEF's for £1,000.00 with the Parish Council making up the difference. Parish Council is to contact Selby District Council and the Doctors about siting the Defibrillator on the wall of the Anne Sharpe Centre said that he would be willing to attend a training course to use one and the Parish Council were happy to put the balance towards it.

- **Walkabout**

Parish Councillors Mitchell & Wharton discussed all the points raised with Barbara Scargill of Selby District Council and these were accordingly documented in an email. Also raised was the tenants problem brought up at the last Parish Council Meeting and subsequent email to/from Parish Councillor Mitchell and Barbara Scargill who then both visited the property after the walkabout. Work is now progressing on the property.
