RCIA CLASSES AT OLMC ARE BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 21

The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is the process through which adults learn the basic teachings and practices of the Catholic Church to discern and prepare themselves for reception of the **Sacraments of Initiation**: Baptism (or a Profession of Faith, if already baptized in another Faith Tradition), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist.

If you, or someone you know, is interested in **learning** more about the Catholic Faith or considering becoming Catholic, encourage them to participate in our series of **weekly classes** which begin on **Wednesday evening, September 21, from 7:30-9:00 PM at OLMC** in O'Donnell Hall.

The Classes are also open to any Catholic adults who may be interested in a refresher course in the basic teachings of the Catholic Faith, or willing to be a sponsor for one of the Adult students.

Reception of the **Sacraments of Initiation** will be administered, for those interested, at the *Easter Vigil Mass*, on Saturday evening, **April 8, 2023**.

Imagine being among those who heard Jesus address the Pharisees and scribes in the encounter we hear in today's Gospel: "What man among you having a hundred sheep and losing one of them would not leave the ninety-nine in the desert and go after the lost one until he finds it?" Would you leave ninety-nine in the desert in order to find one lost sheep? In the parable, Jesus is showing us the depths of God's love, the illogical, incredible love God has for each of us. Moses counted on this loving mercy as he spoke for the wandering people; Saint Paul acknowledges his reliance on it in his letter to Timothy.
