**Sub:** Collegiate Education- Celebration of Education Week from 11<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2026 as part of 99 days Praja Palana Pragathi Pranalika-- Implementation of Action Plan- Guidelines Issued- Reg.

All the Principals of Government Degree Colleges in the State are hereby informed that **Education Week** will be celebrated from **11th May to 17th May 2026** across Telangana as part of 99 days Praja Palana Pragathi Pranalika.

A tentative Day-wise Action Plan is enclosed herewith as Annexure. All colleges shall ensure its effective implementation with a focus on visibility, outreach, and showcasing institutional strengths. Any instructions or changes in action plan from government will be communicated in due course.

**Guidelines for Implementation**

- All colleges shall organize the prescribed day-wise activities in a structured and impactful manner, ensuring active participation of students, faculty, alumni, and stakeholders, thereby reflecting the vibrancy of Government Degree Colleges.
- The entire week shall be treated as a major public outreach initiative, and Principals shall ensure that Degree College education, including industry-aligned UG programmes and AEDP, is effectively taken to the public to enhance awareness and admissions.
- Wide publicity shall be ensured for all activities through print and electronic media. Special emphasis shall be laid on the Grand Inaugural on Day 1, ensuring the presence of local leaders, media, and community participation.
- During district and constituency level programmes, colleges shall proactively participate by:
  - Presenting institutional achievements and student success stories
  - Organizing cultural performances such as welcome songs and dances

- Showcasing innovations, projects, and best practices
- All activities shall be systematically documented through photographs, videos, and reports. Colleges shall be prepared to submit compliance reports and documentation at short notice as required.
- Expenditure towards banners, flexes, brochures, publicity materials, and related logistics shall be met from available college funds.
- Principals shall ensure close coordination with District Administration, local bodies, CSR partners, and other stakeholders to maximize outreach and impact of the programmes.
- The programme shall be conducted with a focus on community engagement, enrolment promotion, and showcasing employability-oriented education, making it a meaningful interface between colleges and society.
- Principals are instructed to ensure active participation of students in the scheduled activities under the supervision of teaching and non-teaching staff. All teaching and non-teaching staff shall attend the college from 10th to 17th May 2026, and their attendance shall be mandatorily recorded through the FRS system.

All Principals are hereby directed to ensure that the Education Week is conducted successfully, visibly, and with high public engagement, positioning Government Degree Colleges as centres of quality, skill-oriented, and employability-driven higher education.

### **DAY WISE 7 DAYS ACTION PLAN**

#### **Day 1 – 11 May 2026 (College Level)**

##### **Infrastructure Grounding and Opening day**

- Grand Inaugural of 7day Education week action plan with release of brochures and flex banners involving local leaders and the press.
- Foundation stone laying for all works that have been sanctioned but are yet to be grounded, at district, constituency and institution levels.
- Inauguration of completed academic and administrative blocks.
- MoUs with Sector skill councils and other industry partners who are facilitating internships/ apprenticeships/placements.
- Release of compendium on online e-resources.

#### **Day 2 - 12 May 2026 (District level)**

##### **Student Academic Support & Wellness Initiatives**

- PG Entrance Coaching Inaugural at Erstwhile District ID college level.
- Arrange Yoga and Meditation sessions involving local yoga experts.

#### **Day 3 - 13 May 2026 (Constituency level)**

##### **Village level Academic Support Conclave**

- Orientation / training of Sarpanches shall be organized, with all education departments participating. In urban areas, Corporators may be involved similarly.
- The focus will be on enrolment and bringing youth back into educational institutions across levels.
- High-performing students, teachers, principals, institutions will be recognized and felicitated in the program.
- Sarpanches will be made aware of introduction of Industry linked skilling courses like AEDPs in Degree colleges and they will be given enrolment targets and outstanding Colleges will be felicitated for strong enrolment and pass percentage.
- Degree Colleges to showcase their progress, achievements and innovative projects.

#### **Day 4 - 14 May 2026 (College level)**

##### **Mega Parent Teacher Meeting**

- Outreach Campaign and Mega PTM shall be organized, with special focus on enrolment and parent engagement.
- Student academic performance shall be shared with parents, including through WhatsApp where applicable.

- Medical and Blood Donation camps will be arranged at college level for teaching and non-teaching staff and parents in association with local clubs.
- Walk through of college through all laboratories, library, classrooms and other infrastructural facilities.
- Organize alumni meets and felicitate distinguished and successful alumni.
- Organize CPDC (College planning and development council) Meeting.

#### **Day 5 - 15 May 2026 (College level)**

##### **Mana Grandhalaya Gnyanotsavam**

- Library Day shall be observed across departments, with libraries promoted as knowledge centers.
- Activities will include book exhibitions, book releases, theme-based displays, book talk sessions, felicitation of best readers, and showcasing the history / milestones of libraries.
- Encourage Book donations to enrich library book collection.
- Selected student visits will be organized to archives / manuscript institutions along with awareness sessions.
- Invite and create awareness among Press reporters regarding the available library facilities and facilitate them to utilize the library for their reference.
