BED OF NAILS, a feature length horror film starring DEANNA MARINE as Sky, ERIN PEARL as Lisa and CARSON CAROLLO as Jason. Three young Goth kids who cut through rural central Florida on their way to Lisa's sisters house in Key West. Leaving Atlanta the trio is delayed in the middle of Florida due to an unexpected flat tire. After putting on the temporary spare, the trio backtracks to one of the small towns they recently went through to get the tire fixed. There they encounter two arrogant Florida rednecks played by MARK FRANCIS as Bobby Lee and WESLEY MONIACI as Skeeter. After a brief encounter with the rednecks the trio moves on and shortly thereafter find a secluded wooded area to pitch a tent for the night back off the road on the edge of the Green Swamp. There they encounter the same pair of rednecks from the tire store and two additional rednecks played by ERIK SIZEMORE as Leroy and KEN VATHAUER as Bufort. The rednecks only intend to harass and humiliate the teens but when a gun unexpectedly goes off and leaves one of the teens dead the only logical thing to do to the rednecks is to kill the remaining two and bury or dump the bodies in the swamp. Only one thing that the rednecks didn't expect, Sky is a practicing witch and returns from the grave to enact a brutal revenge. Featuring an incredible soundtrack from the artists, Liers in Wait and Empire 44, the viewer will experience the unique way filmmaker Michael Malott incorporates the use of music to drive the films visuals with a truly exciting result.

Bed of Nails is an edge of your seat thriller that is often compared to, I Spit on your Grave, U-Turn and House of 1000 Corpses.

Since January 2023,, Bed of Nails has won a total of over 60 film festival awards from over 30 film festivals.

Bed of Nails is unrated, but is intended for mature audiences only. The film contains graphic violence, language, nudity, rape and terror.

THE PRODUCTION

In the middle of the Covid pandemic a small cast and crew assembled and took over a former children's camp located in the middle of the Green Swamp in Lacoochee, Florida. Literally filming in a swamp was never a vision for my film. In fact, original filming locations were scouted in a whole different direction which I had frequently travelled through on trips with my son to Disney including Arcadia, Fort Meade, and Zolfo Springs. A Craigslist ad landed the project the perfect filming location just outside Dade City, Florida. The property served as a weekend getaway for a prominent Tampa construction mogul. Filming commenced in mid-September, 2021 and eventually wrapped in mid-October, a couple days behind schedule. I think we all were amazed that we had kept it together long enough to pull off filming enough footage to assemble a feature film. The camp served as the primary filming location for the majority of filming and housed most of the cast and crew. Food was catered in twice daily by Dawn's cooking out of Dade City. The majority of filming took place all night in the middle of a living swamp complete with all kinds of creatures and strange noises. A number of interesting events highlighted the filming period including a scary encounter with a panther, and an alleged Bigfoot sighting by Mark Francis, and a ceiling fan collision right at the start of filming for actor Wesley Moniaci. One of the most notable incidences that occurred on the set was one night when everyone from the cast and crew was at the main house for dinner except Mark & I, who were sitting out on the set talking. Suddenly from nowhere a huge like branch flew out and fell like ten yards from us. The thing unusual about this was that, this thing flew sideways and it was too large for anyone to throw like that. I had figured a limb broke and while falling hit another limb which jettisoned it sideways, but that theory was unfounded, especially after you could hear rustling in the woods nearby. I radioed to the house and several people rushed back out, shortly after this, Mark claimed to have seen Bigfoot?

The camp was situated about a quarter mile back off the road and featured a crackhead trailer park a half mile down one way and another crackhead trailer park a half mile down the opposite direction and at a location where human remains were always being discovered which added to the excitement. The production was fortunate to hook up with a local resident named, Randy Spainhour who served as the productions location manager and his home is featured in the movie as Skeeter's residence. Randy also arranged for the use of the very redneck tow truck that Leroy is seen driving in the movie. The tow truck is owned by very real "rural" Florida guys who actually make moonshine, so working with them was quite interesting. Down time was spent hanging out at the house and with several musicians there, including Mark who credits himself as a former guitarist for Alice Cooper and Whitesnake, there was lots of live music, but we had all had enough of campfires and the outdoors from filming.

To end off a perfect three weeks of very long filming days, a couple days before we wrapped we were informed that we had all along been staying and filming on an Indian burial ground from a famous battle known as the Dade Massacre, exciting! Maybe that can explain some of the strange and bizarre stuff that occurred?

The soundtrack featured in Bed of Nails is primarily the work of Erik Sizemore who also portrays the character of Leroy. Erik and I have been friends for more than two decades and I have a long history with his band's music. Liers in Wait is one of my all-time favorite bands and were way ahead of their time. When I wrote this script I actually wrote it knowing where their music would be going and tailored my script to a lot of the films soundtrack. When editing was complete, only one song was changed from my original ideas and that was because Erik offered me a track that had never been released that was more fitting.

Meet Filmmaker Michael Malott



Michael Malott is a decades long music industry veteran. His work in the entertainment field includes managing Grammy Award winning artists and over 30 years working and touring with some of the biggest names in music. He has a long history in law and holds a degree in law with honors. In 2004, he created the Instruments for the Youth Children's Charity (www.instrumentsfortheyouth.com) which provides free musical instruments to needy children, arranges celebrity visits to children's hospitals and other charitable work. The charity has enjoyed the support of over 100 top name entertainers including such names as KISS, Keith Richards, Billy Joel, Jimmy Buffett, Velvet Revolver and on. The charity and its work have received praise worldwide including the Prime Ministers of Canada and Trinidad and even Nelson Mandela. His work over the years has included 13 gold and platinum awards, two Grammy and an MTV Award credit. He was the creator and producer of the Peter Tosh Tribute Project featuring Eric Clapton, Jerry Garcia, Slash, Sean Paul and others.

In the mid 90's, he was the creator and screenwriter of the Corporate Vacation film project with Bon Jovi's Tico Torres, Frank Bello from Anthrax, Junior Marvin from the Wailers, Emo Philips, Judy Tenuta, Arlo Guthrie and others.

His 2005 benefit album for his Instruments for the Youth Children's Charity featured members of the Police, Rolling Stones, Jefferson Starship, Testament, Steve Vai and others all performing a jazz composition. The track, AFRICA by Pat Martino won a nomination for Grammy for "Best Jazz Instrumental".

Malott left actively touring in the music industry in 2005 to be a full time parent to his autistic son. His son is a well known child celebrity working to raise money for St Jude Children's Hospital through a children's travel book series. His child's efforts have been commended by two U.S. Presidents and he even did a homework project with President Obama who declared his son "An inspiration for special needs children and families everywhere".

Mike's interest in filmmaking lies in creating dark, artsy primarily low budget horror themed films.

As a film director he credits inspiration from such films as Rob Zombie's 31, the 1981 release, Southern Comfort and in particular the 1980's film release, Cruising, a lesser known dark film starring Al Pacino centered on the hardcore gay S&M scene.




