October 8, 2024 Meeting Minutes

- Steve Hartfield, at-large member of Greater Milwaukee Synod Council was a guest.
 - o Synod Council feels there isn't great communication between churches and Synod. Wanted to open communication. They are more than who we contact with a problem or when we need a pastor.
 - o We viewed a video of stories of what the synod is doing in, for, and with congregations: Outreach for Hope and ministries like the Grace Welcome Center, diversity and inclusion, Hispanic ministry.
 - o From Pastor Matt Short: What brings you joy in your ministry? We shared: Outreach ministries, that people that come in our door feel welcome, having a congregation that is curious and not afraid to try things, seeing member make connections between each other and maintaining friendships outside of our walls.
- Pastor Chip shared that he ordered a copy of a book titled, Funding Forward for each Council member.
 - o How do we capitalize on what we already have? His idea is that everyone read it, then a retreat or brainstorming session be planned (separate from a council meeting).
- Pastor Chip was had a discussion with someone potentially interested in a part-time position leading contemporary music for Saturday evening worship. Council approved moving forward with a unanimous vote.
- Angie, Church Administrator, shared that the approximate \$10K in sprinkler system repairs have been completed. These unexpected costs will be covered by Scrip profits and income we have received for building use this year. Angie and Claudia, our Bookkeeper are organizing an audit that will occur in December with a retired auditor who offers his services to non profit organizations.
- The Stewardship campaign kicked off the first weekend in October. Council members signed the letter that will be mailed with intent cards, with the celebration of intents being the first weekend in November. Ministry Moments, highlighting what our offerings support, are planned for each weekend between.
- The financial update was very positive. Our income is up and budgeted expenses are down.
- Sunday School and Confirmation are going great. Our young people are engaged and participating.

- Russ and Ralph will work on a mortgage reduction campaign that will be presented to the congregation at the January annual meeting.
- Tanya and Angie worked on revising the Building Use Policy since June and presented Council with a revised policy in August. It's been reviewed and was official approved by a unanimous vote at this meeting.


CELEBRATING 40 YEARS
