Dear Siblings in Christ,

Grace and peace to you as we step into the season of Advent—these beautiful, hope-filled weeks when the Church leans forward with anticipation, watching for the Light that no darkness can overcome.

December always feels like a season lived in two directions. I hope you will join us for meaningful worship, fellowship, and service opportunities happening this month—from Advent Saturdays/Sundays and other gatherings to Christmas Eve worship. These rhythms anchor us in what really matters: the presence of Emmanuel. God with us.

May your December be filled with grace that steadies you, peace that surrounds you, and joy that surprises you when you least expect it. And may the Christ-child, whose birth we await, make His home once again in your heart.




