
Simmons Island Park Picnic Shelter

Coming soon will be an opportunity to participate in a Grief Support Group. This 10-week grief support group program focuses on important grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The weekly videos feature nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, and the video is followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed.



Past participants have related how helpful the information and follow-up discussions were to them. Many grieving people find they are only beginning the work of healing when friends or family have returned to their daily life routines. Too often people, including Christians, tend to stuff their grief. Don't allow fear of what others may think to keep you from what could help you.

Confidentiality is very much a part of this program. Your bereavement experience may be recent or not so recent. You will find encouragement, comfort, and help in grieving the death of a spouse, child, parent, sibling, other family member, or friend. No matter what the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling.

You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and that you do not need to live in bondage to certain emotions. You will learn valuable information about dealing with the changes in your life and renewing your hope for the future. A free workbook that includes a participant guide which has note-taking outlines, short exercises that can be done at home, journaling prompts, and scripture will be available for each participant. Each session will last two hours with a video and small group discussion. Grief Share is for adults who are grieving the death of a family member or friend. Space is limited so make your registration ASAP.

- Grief Share will begin Monday, June 10th and continue every Monday (for 10 weeks)

- Cost: Free, and includes a workbook
