Ah, the fresh morning air!

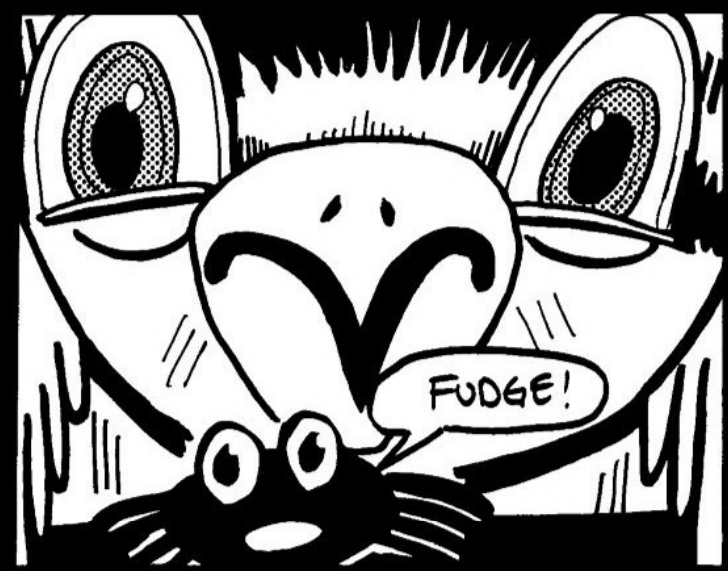


Ho hum

OF THE JUNGLE.



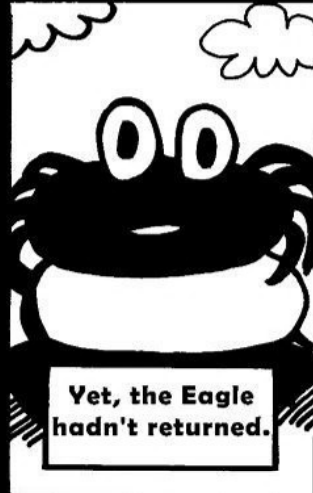
