Coco Mbassi is an international artist whose musical style defies categorisation. She is one of the great artists whose timeless music connects both her faithful fanbase and the younger, more recently connected generations. Her music draws its inspiration from jazz, soul and gospel, and also draws on baroque and classical music. Thanks to her undeniable vocal talent which stands out in the crowded musical landscape, her malleable voice has rocked a whole generation of fans around the world. The outstanding artist has released 4 albums to date (Sepia in 2001, Sisea in 2003, Jóa in 2014 and Ashuka Series Vol. 1 in 2020) and one single (Palaba in 2021), and each release represents a different facet of a musical body of work that transcends time, fashion and trends. Although she sings mainly in Duala (a Bantu language from Cameroon), Coco Mbassi is a citizen of the world who conveys universal messages such as love, joy and hope.

After 3 years devoted to theatre and musicals (as an actress, a scriptwriter, and a playwright), during which she maintained regular contact with her community on her social media pages, the artist is preparing a much anticipated and long-awaited return to song, with the upcoming release of a brand new 3-track EP. This musical project promises to be just as innovative as her previous releases, displaying the unique artistic singularity she's known for. 2023 promises to be colourful with the release of this new EP which will take listeners on a journey, a tasteful blend of cultures, an invitation to dance and an ode to joy.
