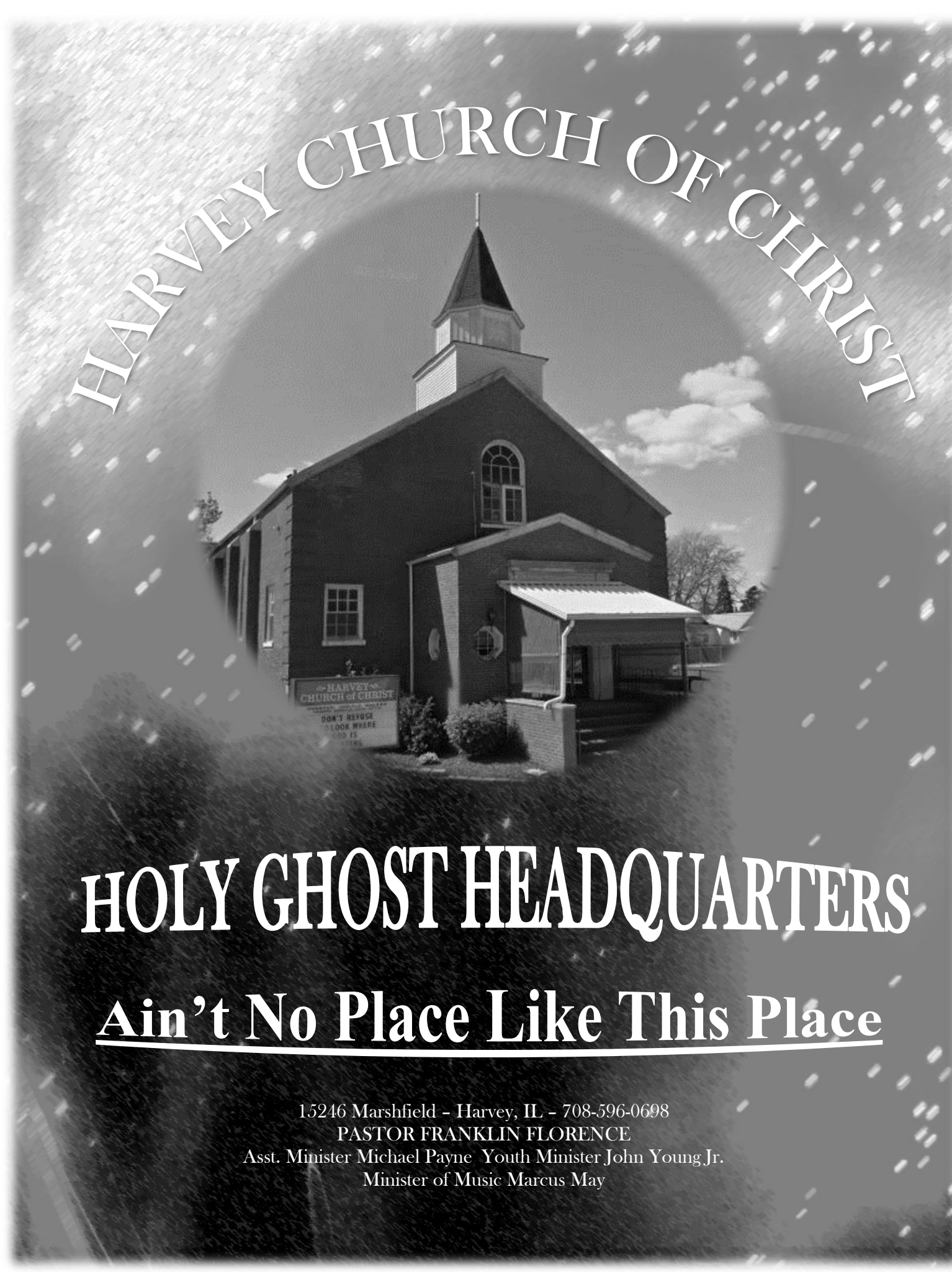

Here are some things you can do to get through a bad mental health day

1. Practice Acceptance  
When you start to realize today is just not your day, one thing you can do is practice accepting it. Tell yourself "obviously today isn't going quite as I planned. My brain doesn't want to work with me, and that's OK. I can go easy on myself today and hope for a better day tomorrow."
2. Let go of Your Own Judgement On a bad mental health day, you want to avoid making yourself feel worse than necessary. Instead you can stop telling yourself "I'm such a failure for not being able to control my anxiety/depression right now."
3. Continue to Take Action and Try Not to Sulk Don't give into your current mindset. Work on taking action even if you aren't feeling it.  
Practice things that you know will help. I deep clean my home because when things are clean, I feel a lot better.
