Scholarship Guidelines

Available Scholarships

One-time scholarship ranging from \$500 - \$1000+ will be awarded in the fall of 2024. All scholarships awarded are for use during the 2023-24 academic year. The deadline for requesting awarded funds for the 2023-2024 academic vear is December 31, 2024. Applicants not attending the first semester must submit a letter requesting a delay for funds. The deadline for this funds request must be received/emailed or postmarked by December 31, 2024.

Eligibility

Students whom meet the following criteria are eligible and encouraged to apply.

- Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher
- Currently enrolled or plans to enroll in the following year as a full-time student in a four-year program at an accredited college/university or accredited technical/trade school.
- Active participation in school, community/volunteer service, and/or faith-based activities.

Application Procedures

A prepared scholarship folder may be submitted. It must include the following **required** items:

Completed printed or typed application form. Read and follow all the directions on the form.

Official Grades and Transcripts. Transcript must include grades for the last 3 years including 12th grade subjects in progress; if possible, include official 12th grade test scores.

Letters of Recommendation. Two (2) personal letters of recommendations on letterhead from individuals who know of your abilities and potentials. No letters from relatives.

Personal Essay. Limited to a minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 750 words in which you respond to <u>ONLY ONE</u> of the prompted statements in the application.

Scholarship Award and Recommendations

Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection for the scholarship award. The recipient must submit acceptance of the award as indicated in the letter of notification.

Distribution of the scholarship be made upon receipt of from the college verification university; of the recipient's college/technical school status and enrollment. The scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the institution of higher learning.

Note:

Applicants are not eligible to receive a from Links, scholarship The Incorporated, Anchorage Chapter if the applicants accept a scholarship which awards full tuition, room and board; a three or four year ROTC scholarship; and/or appointment to a military academy.
