

Dress Code for Dance Infinity SA

Dance is a discipline and therefore requires the proper attire. Dance clothes are designed for movement and for keeping the dancer's muscles warm which will help prevent injuries. It also allows instructors to see the proper body alignment to make corrections.

Tiny Two's & Pre 1, 2, 3: Pink leotard, pink tights. Black tap shoes, pink ballet shoes. Ballet skirt optional as cover up and can be any color.

Tap/Jazz and Jazz Combo Classes: Any color leotard, leggings/jazz pants. Black tap shoes, black jazz shoes.

All Ballet Classes: Black leotard, pink tights. Pink ballet shoes. Ballet skirt optional as cover up and can be any color.

Contemporary/Lyrical/Modern: Black leotard, dark leggings/footless tights. Lyrical shoes.

Jazz and Dance Team: Any color leotard, jazz pants. Tan jazz shoes.

Musical Theater/Drama: Any color leotard, leggings/jazz pants. Black jazz shoes.

Hip Hop and Hip Hop Combo Classes: Any color leotard, leggings/cargo/hip hop pants. Black jazz shoes.

Acro: Any color leotard and bike shorts all in one uni-tard. Barefoot for this class.

Boys: White t-shirt, black jazz pants or black long basketball shorts. Sweat pants when its cold. Depending on class- black tap shoes, black ballet shoes, black jazz shoes.

Adults: Workout clothes and appropriate shoes for the class participating in.

All Students:

Absolutely No shorts- we do not want to see things we shouldn't while stretching on the floor.

Crop tops and sports bras must be to belly button to be worn alone.

Bike shorts should be longer than mid-thigh or you MUST wear tights with them.

No T-shirts-it hides body alignment and keeps the instructor from making proper adjustments and corrections.

Sports bras should be worn under leotards/crop tops. Hair should be pulled up and jewelry should be removed. Absolutely no gum in class and only water is permitted.
