

PRE-HOSPITAL IMMEDIATE CARE IN SPORT – Level 3

11-12 Nov 2021

This 2-day course addresses the immediate care training needs for doctors, nurses, physiotherapists and on-site personnel working within all sports. The course integrates basic and advanced life support, pre-hospital and advanced trauma life support, on-field assessment of concussion and spinal care, in sport-specific contexts.

This course is conducted by an international teaching faculty with extensive experience in pre-hospital immediate care and sports medicine education.

Based in the UK, PHICIS has been running for 14 years, it is now is taught in multiple countries and has been adopted as the model of care by World Rugby.
