Not required, but if you have it (no matter if it is expired, still bring it with you as it just prove that you are U.S. Citizens). Please read below (travel documents) for more information.

Travel Documents:

U.S. citizens taking a "closed-loop" cruises (sailing that both originate & terminate in the same U.S. port) are NOT required to have a valid passport book, but will need proof of citizenship such as an original or certified copy of a birth certificate or a certificate of naturalization, a passport card, an REAL ID driver's license as well as a government-issued photo ID. Children are also required to bring proof of citizenship and if 16 and over a photo ID is also required. Starting May 7, 2025, U.S. travelers MUST be REAL ID (driver license with star), if you do not have it then you need upgrade your driver license. For ladies, need to bring marriage certificate & original birth certificate and your REAL ID must match to married last name. Or bring U.S. passport book with regular driver license. Your choice. Ask Maria, for more details.

All other non US citizens must have a passport book and/or the appropriate documentation for air, land & sea travel to Hawaii. For more information, please visit visa central at <https://visacentral.com/>



Norwegian sell travel protection insurance. There are two different type of travel protection insurances. Standard Plan & Platinum Plan

Standard Plan - If you need to cancel your trip for any reason and you would get about 75% of cruise penalty. Emergency Evacuation is up to \$25,000.

Platinum Plan - If you need to cancel your trip for any reason and you would get about 90% of cruise penalty. Emergency Evacuation is up to \$50,000.

The Air Service Fee of round trip is \$25 (one way or round trip) non-refundable per person. Maria & Bobby's Deaf Travel will use Flights by Norwegian Promo Air as Buy one and 2nd guest fly free — the best rates with restriction. As long as Maria & Bobby's Deaf Travel have a copy of your Real ID (driver License or State ID) or U.S. passport book in their file. Also, you do not need to pay the flight now and the flexibility to change flights with no change fee before final payment date due, February 13, 2026.

NOTE: You can book your own Air (flight) - but you need to check with your travel agent, Maria, first before you buy air tickets because Norwegian has rules about time of arrival and depart on same sailing dates and you will not be able to get Norwegian's Shuttle/Transfer unless you fly the same date as sailing date without staying hotel. DAY 1 - Sat, Aug 1 ~ Honolulu, Oahu ~ Average Temperature 74° - 88°



The big, blue Pacific and stunning Koolau mountains serve as a dramatic setting for Hawaii's largest city. Climb to the top of Diamond Head. Take a romantic sunset stroll on Waikiki Beach. Catch a glimpse of history by visiting Pearl Harbor and the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific.

DAY 2 & 3 - Sun, Aug 2 & Mon, Aug 3 ~ Kahului, Maui ~ Average Temperature 71° - 88°
