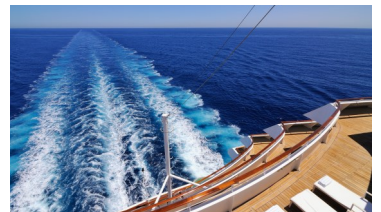
DAY 6 - Tues, April 1 ~ Hiroshima, Japan ~ Average Temperature 61° H / 46° L
