

TUSKEGEE UNIVERSITY ALUMNI CLUB OF CENTRAL TEXAS RETURNING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Tuskegee University Alumni Club of Central Texas (TUACCT) administers a scholarship program that offers scholarships to students at Tuskegee University whose home residence is within the TUACCT area of influence as defined by its current Bylaws.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible, applicants must meet all the following criteria:

1. Complete application form
2. Be a resident of TUACCT area of influence, which includes the following Texas Counties:

Bastrop	Bell	Bexar	Blanco
Burnet	Coryell	Gillespie	Hays
Lampasas	Lee	Llano	Falls
McLennan	Milam	Travis	Williamson
3. Be a full-time student at Tuskegee University.
4. Entering second year through graduate studies at Tuskegee University.
5. Shall not be on probation.
6. 2.5/4.0 cumulative Grade Point Average or higher.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS / PROCEDURE

Applicants must submit or complete the following REQUIRED items prior to the application deadline. All applications must be completed electronically.

1. Scholarship application. Electronic version available from <https://forms.gle/CA8cVz9rxds1wZ8p8>
2. 300 to 500-word essay on one of the following topics:
 - a. Discuss a current global issue and explain how you would propose a solution to address the issue.
 - b. Describe a personal experience that influenced your decision to pursue your field of study.

- c. How would you define leadership? Share a time when you demonstrated leadership and the impact it had on those around you.

Essays must be an original work by the applicant. Artificial Intelligence (AI) generated essays are not allowed. Submission of AI generated essays will result in the applicant being disqualified.

3. Schedule an interview with TUACCT Scholarship Committee. (Interview to be completed as scheduled by committee prior to scholarship determination.)
4. Applicants can submit a copy of the Unofficial Transcript from the Tuskegee Tigerweb system or an official transcript from the registrar's office. Transcript must include the grades for the 2025 Spring semester. TUACCT reserves the right to request the official transcript at a later date, if needed.
5. Personal Resume. Resume should include relevant academic work, publications, as well as any prior work experience.

Applicants may optionally submit:

1. Letters of recommendation on official letter head. (Maximum of 2)
2. Personal statement with regards to unique circumstances or need.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Each application is reviewed and scored based on the content of the completed submission.

Scoring is based on a 100-point system for required content.

Additional points may be awarded for optional content.

Applicants must receive a minimum score of 70/100 to be awarded a scholarship.

Notification of scholarship awards will be on or before August 15, 2025.
