### What is the NJROTC Booster Club?

The NJROTC Booster Club is comprised of the parents of current NJROTC cadets. Our purpose is to help fund and organize activities for the cadets, assist in meeting the needs of the cadets as well as provide scholarships to graduating senior cadets. Last year, we awarded over \$7,300.00 in scholarships to our graduating cadets!

With the support of the NJROTC instructor, Chief Barry Harvey, our children are actively engaged in the community throughout the year. Our Booster Club initiates several activities, in addition to the NJROTC's program, to promote this endeavor, your cadets can earn community service hours by participating in food collection/pantry stocking, roadside clean up and yellow ribbon welcome home events just to name a few. We also have fundraising events scattered throughout the year to raise funds for our cadets. We continue to host our annual Drill Meet (October 2022). This is your cadets' moment to shine, as this Drill Meet is for NS1 cadets!

### DID YOU KNOW....

- You can attend as many or as little Booster Club meetings as you are able, but you do not need to attend any to be a participating member.
- Membership Dues are \$35 per family if paid before Dec. 1, and \$40 after Dec. 1. The dues help to increase the scholarship fund. As an incentive from the instructors, by becoming a Paid Booster Club member your cadet will receive a free hooded NJROTC sweatshirt and sweatpants.

The Booster Club Meetings will resume on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 (in the CHS NJROTC classroom) at 7pm to start the 2022- 2023 school year.
