minister's message

1 Corinthians 13:1-7 RSV

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. 2 And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3 If I give away all I have, and if I deliver my body to be burned, [a] but have not love, I gain nothing. 4 Love is patient and kind; love is not jealous or boastful; 5 it is not arrogant or rude. Love does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; 6 it does not rejoice at wrong, but rejoices in the right. 7 Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

When Paul writes this epistle to the Church at Corinth, he makes a bold statement but a true one. Love is the driving force behind salvation, reconciliation, and forgiveness. As the bible says, "for God so loved the world...". Not the world as in the earth as a creation. The

world means the collection of men and women from the beginning of time till the end. Not just the religious folk either! He is rich in grace and mercy and the one word that sums up who God is, is love. Love is patient or as some translations say longsuffering.

There are a plethora of gifts, powers, and talents that a person can behold but if he or she is not using them in love it is all in vain. We need not be confused about what Love looks like to display it or experience it. 1 Corinthians 13 tells us exactly what love looks like. Patience, kindness, not jealous or boastful, not arrogant or rude, does not insist on its own way, not irritable or resentful, does not rejoice at wrong, bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things is what Paul says about love. So who doesn't know about love? Of course we know about love. It is in the times of hate and evil that we must remember to love. As shocking as it may sound, there are some who do not know love. Therefore, the children of God must be the beacons of light to show love to the loveless. Amen.
