The Benefits of Faith

Philemon 4-7; 8-20

There are many expressions of faith in the Bible. Often there are people we find in the Old Testament who show little if any faith at all. One example is Gideon and his expressions of doubt when the Lord asked him to go, "If the Lord is with us, then why is this happening to us, what has He done for us..., how can I deliver Israel..., before I go, I need you to show me a sign, (Judges 6:13). When God called Moses to go for Him, Moses said, "Who am I? What am I going to say? What am I going to tell the people?" I don't think Moses lacked faith in God; after all he is the man who walked away from the Palaces of Egypt to follow God and his people. It seems more of a lack of faith in his ability to go in God's name.

What I love about Paul is that his faith is balanced in every situation. Hearing him speak of commitment to Christ he said, "I've learned in whatsoever state I'm in to be content" a solid, expression of an

unmoved state of being. Again, "I know whom I have believed and am persuaded He is able to keep what I have committed to Him against that Day." Some people equate faith with an emotional hope. When trouble, tribulation or their midnight comes, they get pushed around. But faith in God, knowing who he is and what he has done is where the focus needs to be.

Faith is a basic principle, "Without faith it's impossible to please God, for he that cometh to God must believe that he is and rewards those who diligently seek Him" (Hebrew 11:6). Faith is about our actions. Show me a man who has faith and I'll show you his works (James 2:14). The prayer is "Increase our faith and help our unbelief."

Faith gives us the opportunity to live in the eternal life to come. It allows us to see beyond our present situations. It comes from God and the promises he made in His word through Christ. What more do we need to keep faith and hope alive? Preach the gospel, keep the faith and stand on the promises of God.


