The past year has been a revealing year of injustice in America. It has shown how important it is to emphasize and speak out against human injustice. We are from one God who has made all of us one race, the human race in which we all equally

Justice is an attribute of God that speaks to His Holiness. Holiness is the essence of God's nature sacred and pure, uncontaminated by evil and separated from all that is corrupt in the world. In this sense God is the Righteous Judge of all the earth, being the spirit of all that is just, good and fair for everyone. Justice is a regard for the rights of other human beings with the purpose to preserve them.

Looking forward what kind of voice should Christians have to speak for racial, social-economic righteousness and justice anywhere in the world? What will we do to educate, inform and motivate people to engage in "good and necessary trouble" to bring evil men to repentance? Yes, to repentance because no sinful man can honestly be just. To get there does require active engagement.

Amos called for justice because God, who is Just, sent him to indict any people who mistreat even their enemy devoid of human dignity. God addresses injustice everywhere and He simply judges it as sin. Amos called out human injustices perpethat God is universal in his judgment of man's sins against man. He calls out: moral, social other nation who treats people inhumanely and turns away as if there is nothing to see. and political corruption in Amos' prophecy for divine justice.

Syria for inhumane treatment; beating war captives with iron spiked timbers

Philistia for slave trafficking (1:6); and Phoenicia for slave trading with Edom (Amos

Edom, descendants of Esau, Jacobs brother, for perpetual enmity and hatred for Israel (Amos 1:11).

The Ammonites in that they ripped up pregnant women as they invaded another country, as a way to enlarge their borders (Amos 1:13).

Moab demonstrated inhumane cruelty by burning the bones of the dead and making them into lime (Amos 2:1).

Judah's sin was religious apostasy — "they rejected the law of the Lord and turned to

The sins of Israel against God included oppression of the poor, taking bribes, dishonesty in business dealings, material excessiveness, moral bankruptcy, even a false religious confidence in their self-elevated righteousness. This was the result of their turning away from God and turning to idolatry. It was their departure from God that led them to injustice, hardness of heart and immorality with no regard for the poor or moral conduct. "because they sell the righteous for silver and the needy for a pair of shoes" (Amos 2:6-7).

America prides herself on being a great nation a beacon of light for the world to imitate. Yet I have heard the question, is this America? more in recent days than any time I can trated not only by the Jewish people but by the other surrounding nations. This tells us remember. The answer is yes this is America. And yes, America stands judged just like any






