God's Protection

Psalm 91:14-16

The context of this Psalm is timeless and appropriate for God's people in any trying situation. Four divine names are used to describe the as it would be in loving the Lord with all his heart. His commitment is to God in whom he places his trust for protection from his enemies. He is the the Lord. Cf. God's commitment came first— (Deut. 7:7-9; 10:15) v. 14; I "Most High", suggesting God's supremacy, Creator and Sustainer - Genewill deliver. sis 14:17-24; "Almighty"- the power of God (Cf. Ex. 6:3); "The Lord"speaking of the covenant relationship name which the Lord revealed himself to His people (Ex. 3:14, 12); and "My God"- a personal claim on his loyalty". relationship, "in whom I trust." The names invoked for help show how willing God is to bring the full capacity of His Person to deliver His people. It speaks of God's promise, providence and pledge to protect the people who love Him against any opposing adversary.

God's Promise is of protection from every enemy...and His care for his servants..., (Psalm 91:1-6).

God's Providence is intervention, to deliver those who trust and abide in Him; they are protected from evil men (v. 7-13).

God's Pledge of love and commitment 91:14-16 – is an 8-fold

response and blessing for those who make God their refuge: Trust in the Lord, is compared to taking shelter and shadow v.1, under the cover of his wing, a refuge and habitation—see v.2, v.9., "in whom I will trust"—is addressed by the Lord:

"Because he cleaves to me in love..." means that his heart is set on the Lord

"Because he knows my name..." a relationship that rests on revelation— (Cf. Psalm 76:1; Ex. 34:5-7), "I will protect him... is His "covenant-

"When he (my servant) calls to me" ... I will answer; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue; I will satisfy—with long life... and I will show him my salvation—protection and deliverance. (Psalm 91:15).

Romans 8:28, "Everything works together for good, with those who love the Lord and are called according to his purpose." Nothing can touch God's servant but by His absence, and when is He ever absent except when we turn away from Him.




