Many times as Christians we will be called upon to serve. Some have already accepted their calling, while others are awaiting the call. No matter which category you fall into, when the Lord calls you to service the best and blessed thing you can do is obey with a pure heart. It serves us nothing to say we will do something but then not follow through with it.

As Jesus explained through this parable, God had called the Israelites to be His chosen people. They accepted that calling and said that they would serve the Lord God and Him alone. Yet time and time again they served other idols and pagan gods. They failed to be the people that God called Jesus said to them, "Truly I tell you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God ahead of you. ³² For John came to you to show you the way of righteousness, and you did not believe him, but the tax collectors and the prostitutes did. And even after you saw this, you did not

This is why Jesus responds to the people saying the tax collectors and prostitutes have heard the call and are entering the Kingdom of Heaven. Tax collectors and prostitutes denotes the notion of people we would not think would find God and be transformed, yet this is the kind of people Jesus came to save. And they responded even more than the so-called chosen people who view themselves as righteous by birthright alone.

Now, this is our time to be true servants of the Lord, not by lip service or by dragging, kicking and screaming. It is time for us to embrace true servanthood and not lip service. No longer finding excuses for why we haven't done what we know is right, or giving empty promises of service. Now is the time to be about the Father's business!




