To God Be the Glory, In the Church

Ephesians 3:20-21

The challenge of the first century church in its mission for Christ was to convince the world that the resurrection and ascension of Christ to be seated at the right-hand of God in heaven did happen as God had planned. The church moved in faith and resolved to proclaim the gospel of Christ. The "good news" was in fact, that Jesus gave His life and rose from the dead as the testimony of God's plan to redeem mankind in a body of believers called the church.

The church was called to share in the glory of Christ through the resurrection. Faith in Christ as the resurrected Lord and Savior is the foundation of new life in the church (Acts 2:36-40). Those who believe in Him are saved by Him.

Being saved by Him, the church bears witnesses to the truth of His teaching and salvation. In the church, the message of salvation is to love, forgive, share redemption, grace and hold the expectation that God will complete all that He has promised to bring the divine and all men together in Christ.

In addition, *many world religions* are challenged to believe that Christ is not just another prophet among others, but that He is the only "begotten" and chosen "Son of God" prophetically, historically and eternally. As a result of God's appointment of Christ, through and by the power of His resurrection, followers of Christ are given the distinction of being empowered to live for God by faith in, by that same resurrection of Christ. Thus Christians are called to form one body of believers known as the church through which God's manifold wisdom and salvation is made known the world.
