DEEPLY LOVE ONE ANOTHER FROM THE HEART

1 Peter 1:22-25 22 Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart. 23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. 24 For, "All people are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, 25 but the word of the Lord endures forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.

Peter, in his first letter to the believers speaks a lot about hope. Peter is teaching the believers to look beyond their present time and to rejoice in the glory that is to come. Hope is a major theme for all Christians. Hope leads to faith, and faith leads to salvation. Accompanied with hope is another major theme: love. For Christians, it is the catalyst that brought about the coming of a savior

in Jesus Christ according to John 3:16. Here Peter makes some important distinctions about love. He does not begin with love right away, but instead he first speaks about the process of purification. Christian love, the kind that Peter is talking about does not come in our sinful carnal nature. We first needed the love that Christ brought and to obey the truth that He revealed. Only when we have gone through the process of being born again can we truly understand how to "deeply love one another from the heart." So then, let us not be confused when we see people who hate rather than love. Let us not be confused when we encounter individuals who do not know the word of God. It is the job of every Christian to spread the truth about the Gospel and to show the world the Love of Jesus and the hope of salvation. Only then will we see the changes that we desire.


