# minister's message

### "In These Things I Delight"

Jeremiah 9:24

"But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth; for in these things I delight, says the Lord."

If I my life's desire is to know the Lord, then I must learn to practice steadfast love, justice and righteousness with all men.

The Hebrew word for justice can refer to a justice of punishment which means, if I steal something, I must pay the consequences exacted by a standard, or law and receive what I deserve. But most often in the Bible, the word justice is the idea of "restorative justice". Restorative justice goes beyond punishment and seeks to mend relationships broken by the harm done to another. It supports the notion of speaking for the vulnerable who are disadvantaged or mistreated and looking for way to repair the harm done to them by another in (Proverbs 31:8-9). Another name for this is simply, love—seeking the highest good of another at the expense of one's self.

This is what Jesus did for us, He loved us and died for us. He put our interest and well-being before His own. This is why God sees us as righteous due to faith in Christ who was punished for you and me. So we can live a righteous life, *free to serve God* and fellowman aligned with the principle, *love my neighbor as myself*" or love others as Christ has loved us, at the expense of one's self.

My neighbor is essentially any human being made in God's image. It may be the neighbor next door, the stranger I pass on the street or a family member I have known all my life. Hebrews 13:1 says, "Let brotherly love continue, do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers. Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them." This is a call to compassion and empathy for strangers, it could be someone you are at odds with, not your best friend. How would we emulate God's justice, righteousness and steadfast love to His delight? By showing empathy, as if I am in their skin with them, to feel what they feel. Hopefully this would lead us to give them what they need to the delight of the Lord.

Another way to delight the Lord is written in Galatians (6:10), "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially those who are of the household of faith."




