“It Takes a Village”

In order to film a movie from start to finish it requires thousands of people doing hundreds of different tasks. The next time you watch a movie, take a moment to watch the credits. You won't find the same name repeated over and over. Instead of repeating names, there will be a new and different name for each and every component of the movie. The director is not an editor. Grip, gaffer, and focus puller are three different jobs for an array of different people. There is never one person for all the jobs. Christianity has the same principle attached to the gifts that God gives us. The Bible teaches us about this topic and helps to make this task easy.

First, everyone is equal in Christ. *There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus (Galatians 3:28).* Importance or validity in Christ is not determined by money, race, status, talent, gift, or

gender. We are all the same. Second, we all have gifts and talents that we are suppose to use as individual members for the good of the entire body. The Bible says, *“Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms” (1 Peter 4:10).*

The concern then becomes when a “director” steps into the “editor” seat and begins to shape the movie beyond his or her gift for directing. Get in where you fit in. You have a gift, and you have a purpose in the body of Christ. It can be disheartening when members are forced to grow arms like spiders in order to meet the needs of the congregation. Then again, if we know that we are not an encourager, or a teacher, or a greeter or a leader then we do the body a disservice by taking a role that we have not been gifted for. Nonetheless, be encouraged because God has a task for everyone in His movie. Action!




