Amador County was founded in 1854. The first "Amador & Sacramento County Annual Fair" was held in lone in 1887. Established at its current location in 1938, the Amador County Fair became a cherished annual tradition. Located in the heart of the Mother Lode Gold Country, in the Sierra foothills, the fairgrounds is adjacent to historic State Route 49 in Plymouth, CA and nestled in the Shenandoah Valley Wine Region.


