# Rules and Regulations

Lifeguards have full authority to take any action necessary to ensure safety of Club participants and facilities.

1. Stay in your own section while inside/outside of the pool when possible(with your family unit).
2. Member ID required for entry. Members and Guests must sign in at the office. One sign in sheet per family, unit or individual.
3. Children not potty-trained must wear a Swim Diaper. Bandages and other medical wrappings are not allowed in the pool. Admission to the pool will be refused to persons with contagious disease or appearance of being infectious.
4. Lifeguard swim test required for Members under 18, and all guests before going into the deep end(9ft).
5. No diving in 3 ft, middle section of pool, or baby pool.
6. No bicycles, skateboards, heelys, or skates allowed inside the facility.

7. No articles(toys, floatation devices, etc.) allowed in the main pool.
8. No pets
9. No smoking, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, or chewing gum. Food/Drinks allowed at designated tables.
10. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool. All hair, shoulder length or longer, both male and female, must have hair tied back in a ponytail or a swim cap worn.
11. Lane (1) Lap lane: Must be 18 and older to use
12. No running on deck, pushing, throwing, or dunking. No excessive splashing, spitting, or spouting water. No rowdiness, excessive public display of affection or use of profanity. No hanging on the lane lines.

## **Covid-19 Information**

1. Please wear a mask when entering the restrooms as distancing may not always be possible inside the restrooms.
2. Please make sure to wash your hands frequently.
3. We will constantly be cleaning contact surfaces within our facility to try to maintain a safe environment.
4. You do not need to wear a mask when sitting in your own space on the lawn as long as you are socially distant from others. We urge people to wear masks when walking around the facility to respect others.
5. Masks do not need to be worn in the pool. However, spitting of any sort is not allowed.
