Easily board wide walkways with wing doors port and starboard leading into spacious aft deck with custom hardtop, custom wet bar and full eisenglass enclosure. Carpeted sole, helm with raised Captain's bench seat starboard, mate's bench seat port. Opening windows port and starboard and three panel front windshield with opening center. Teak storage chest aft, flanked by teak chairs and end table. Centerline transom gate with ladder to swim platform.

Opening door to quarters below. Saloon with two chairs and custom coffee table starboard. Flat screen and chest port, with buffet cabinet aft. Battery operated automatic Hunter Douglas screen shades, and light sea foam carpeted sole. Two stationary windows port and starboard and two large opening windows port and starboard.

Forward to Hurley designed breakfast bar port with two chairs. Custom breakfast trolley and trash cabinet below. Down three steps to U shaped galley starboard with 3 burner stove, oven, microwave, stainless sink, refrigerator and custom tile sole.

Forward is head, port, with custom vanity sink, toilet and dayhead with second entrance en suite to forward stateroom. Forward stateroom has v berth with opening overhead hatch, two opening portlights, drawers below and hanging locker. Separate electric heat.

Aft, down three steps to aft stateroom with walk around queen berth, large built in dressers and built in night stands port and starboard. Two hanging lockers, six opening portlights and opening overhead hatch. En suite head with vanity custom sink, stall shower with folding door, opening portlight and stone tile sole.

Extra large cushioned bench on foredeck.
