Description

Beautiful 2001 Great Harbour GH37 with new Awlgrip in 2020. Incredible condition! Easy to see in our under cover, fresh water showrooms at Atlantic Yacht Basin on the Intracoastal Waterway just 12 miles South of Norfolk, VA. SHOWBOAT!

Easily board through port or starboard gates to fully enclosed aft deck with hard top. Round table with two chairs aft and built in deep freeze port. Double door opens to saloon with reclining leather sofa and coffee tables port, built in cabinetry with hidden flat screen starboard. Two opening windows port and also starboard, with two opening windows aft, all with custom blinds. Navitik teak and holly sole with access to engine room. Beautiful varnished mahogany woodwork throughout.

Three steps down to U shape galley port with three burner glass top stove and oven and above counter microwave, stainless sink, full size side by side refrigerator, four drawers and seven double lockers. Two opening portlights over stove. Directly across from the galley is office with built in desk, lockers and bookcase with opening portlight. En suite head with vanity sink and toilet and opening portlight.

Moving forward to primary suite with walk around queen, built in hanging lockers and dressers port and starboard, two opening port lights both port and starboard and opening overhead hatch. Aft is vanity sink and entrance to ensuite head port, which has a toilet and a stall shower with opening portlight. Light maple wood sole throughout.

From the saloon up six steps to the pilothouse with centerline helm, opening doors both port and starboard to wide walkways, three panel front windshield and opening windows port and starboard. Large built in L shaped settee converts to queen berth with large opening windows port and starboard, two large opening windows aft, all with custom blinds.

Wide walk ways lead to foredeck with Portuguese bridge and aft deck which is large enough for a 48" dining table and six chairs for al fresco dining. Additionally there is washer/dryer on steps to the flybridge.
