I thought this article was important so I want to pass it on to you. The resource is a doctor, and the article was in the Miami Herald.

## Avoiding FLU and it's Complications

- 1. Get a flu shot. The flu season is not over, and the shot can still protect you.
- If you get the flu (cough, muscle pains and high fever), call your doctor within 24 hours to see about an antiviral drug. They will help but they require a prescription.
- If, a week after getting the flu, you have persistent, constant chest pain that is not just sore muscles, see a doctor, particularly if you are at high risk for heart problems.
- Know the difference between a cold and the flu. The flu usually has a fever, coupled with muscle pain and body aches. The cold normally does not have a fever and more sneezing and coughing.

## **CREAMY GRAPE SALAD**

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese softened
- 1 cup (8 ounces) sour cream
- ½ cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 pounds seedless red grapes
- 2 pounds seedless green grapes
- 4 tablespoons brown sugar
- 5 tablespoons chopped pecans, plus a handful for sprinkling on top.

In a large mixing bowl, beat cream cheese, sour cream, sugar and vanilla with a hand mixer until blended. Add grapes and stir to coat. Transfer to a serving bowl. Cover and refrigerate until serving. Just before serving, add brown sugar and pecans and mix in. Sprinkle with some extra pecans on top and serve. Enjoy
