
The Coco Plum Woman's Club tradition of caring spans over 100 years. These acts of kindness are a way to symbolize our achievements.




### EDUCATION and LIBRARIES COMMUNTIY SERVICE PROGRAM








Our next Book Club meeting is Tuesday, January 16, 12:30 pm in the Boardroom. BYOBL (bring your own bag lunch) some do, some don't.


