I am very proud of our members here at Coco Plum. You all work so hard to make this a very fun and happy club. Keep up the good work.



Many individual library crates have already been made and given to children. There are more books so this project is not over!!



We can't have enough **Doodle Art Coloring Books for adults and colored pencils!!** We made so many men and woman happy when they received their books and pencils we want to continue!!!!




Please continue to bring in more Doodle Art coloring books and colored pencils, I will be
