BRING CANDY (NO CHOCOLATE) TO OUR MEETING ON WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 9th.


October is Domestic Violence Awareness month and the color is Purple. So, at the October meeting if you have something purple, wear it.







- 4. You can send as many boxes as you like, but they must be under 50 pounds.


