Whobalation: How it all started

Seasons of Giving Lake Norman formed in November 2022, yet the inspiration and heart flourished after her grandparents passing in 2017. Her 3 children and herself helped care for them and loved them every day as they resided alone and in assisted living.

When Covid hit, the year after her grandparents passed, her kids brought up the conversation about the lock down all of the assisted living, medical facilities, and hospitals.

Families would no longer be able to see or visit their loved ones. This ultimately would have

been the death of her grandparents if they had lived to this point.

Jaime, who is resourceful and creative, came up with the idea along with her family after watching the Grinch, to bring a little cheer and fundraise to feed seniors in need in Huntersville a Longhorn Meal for Christmas. They would raise money be having photo's with the Grinch.



Jaime, dressed up as the Grinch and her family and friends, dressed as Whovillers. They decorated and lit up (even with a tree on top), her husbands red truck, blasted "Grinch" music as they paraded down every street of their 1000 home neighborhood. Neighbors came out of their homes, kids and adults thankful and ecstatic, to come outside to see the Grinch and finally have conversations with neighbors.. It was a magical experience for all! They raised enough to feed 75 Seniors, many who had not seen anyone in months....

The first delivery changed the lives of all involved. They knocked on the the doors of the community of "Whitehill Senior Apartments," which is independent subsidized housing units in downtown Huntersville. "The one who changed us all was Patricia.



She opened the door, scared and confused, as we were all wearing masks. When she realized what we were doing, she teared up and came outside. She opened her arms and said "You are the first people to visit and knock on my door in 6 months, I love you all and I don't care I am giving each of you a hug!"

In 2021, they again paraded, adding the speedway pace car, decorated trucks, and lots of tacky Christmas themed golf carts! They again raised enough money to feed 350 seniors in Huntersville and Cornelius a Christmas meal with Long Horn Steaks, Nothing Bundt Cakes, and New Big Cozy Blankets. They went door to door with Christmas carols, big smiles, lots of love from the most caring families and children.



In November 2022, Seasons of Giving turned into a Nonprofit, planned their first official fundraiser "The Whobalation at Northstone " in 5 weeks time. With no budget, they reached out to the community for help, and it came. They sold out their event, raised \$7500 and fed 750 seniors in need in the Lake Norman area.

Today they serve two meals a week to 40 seniors, plan and host activities, provide basic needs, help seniors with apartment makeovers by decluttering, repurposing donated furniture and personal touches to make them feel special. W.E ARE FAMILY. WE ARE COMMUNITY

Loved and Cared for more than ever before

Meet Eliza

A Winston-Salem native Mrs. Eliza at 82 years old, calls Huntersville her forever home. She is a widow who has suffered multiple losses of siblings, children, and even grandchildren. Despite these hardships, Eliza's heart remains full of love and her will to survive continues strong. For years, she cared for her daughters two young boys, and since her daughter's passing two years ago, she has not been allowed to see or visit them.

Eliza is devastated by this separation, and feels alone and broken. She remains in Huntersville, as it is the only place the boys know how to find her when they need her.

We began visiting the White Hill Senior Community through our "Seasons of Giving Lake Norman" program. Whitehill is a 65 and older community of independently living subsidized housing. They have no washer or dryers in their units, no dishwashers, and only 2 washers and 2 dryers in the non-ADA compliant Laundry room. The grounds are not ADA compliant and over 50% of the residents are disabled.



We began to understand the true needs of these seniors. We knew it would take time to gain their trust. As we showed up week after week. Mrs. Eliza would greet us with open arms and began to share how Seasons of Giving is impacting her community. "They have done the unimaginable, they have turned this community around. People now come out and talk to each other, the volunteers are truly our family now. We love them and we know they will be there for us because no one else has ever cared in the way that they have cared for our community. We were all dead. Forgotten. But we have been found by the children, the families, and our own neighbors. Never been so happy."

Because of our generous community, business, and volunteers we are able to offer hope to seniors like Mrs. Eliza.

We are family. Seasons of Giving of Lake Norman has brought life to this sleepy, unnoticed, forgotten senior community that has been left to defend for themselves. Many have no family or even friends. There is a lot of loss within families, not only through death but also through abandonment. Many only desire a relationship, someone who cares. We have been able as a community, to serve these seniors and give them a meaning to life. We are refreshing their homes, providing meals and basic necessities, engaging them in activities, spending quality time listening and really getting to know them.

In 2024, our goal is to add the Potts Town Huntersville Community to our outreach. This is another area of independent seniors that live in very old homes in need of repairs, yard work, socialization, activity, meals, and many of the same needs of Whitehill.

The Whobalation at Northstone was held in December 2022 as our inaugural fundraising event. The successful event was quickly planned in less then one month with no budget. With the help of the community around us, and the beliefs and inspirations of what we were doing, we sold out our 300 ticket event, raising over \$7500, and feeding over 700 seniors in need in the LKN area. We provided a Christmas Meal., Nothing Bundt Cakes, Cards and ornaments from local school children and from the event, and gifts made by other seniors. Now this has grown to weekly meals, activities, basic needs and programs.

The event features the Grinch and Santa, with the inspiration of Whoville. Engaging children to build all scenery, teens that volunteer and outreach, businesses who support and engage at the event, cards and ornaments for the seniors, a silent auction and raffle, and a traditional breakfast for dinner Dr. Suess Style. We also have an adult only "Tavern", Grinch Trivia, and a time to bring your co workers, friends, and family to enjoy a night of fellowship while the kids are engaged with the volunteers. This has now become a traditional Christmas Season Event for all.
