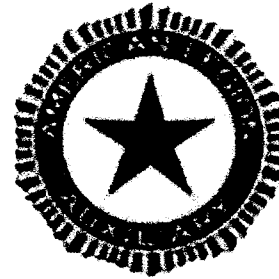
Thank you for all the attendance and excellent attendance and performance.
