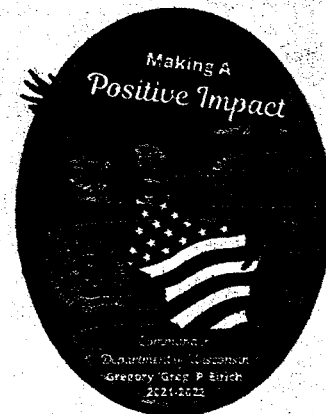
It is the pleasure of all the Americanism Committee members to be able to go and present programs. I want to thank Dan

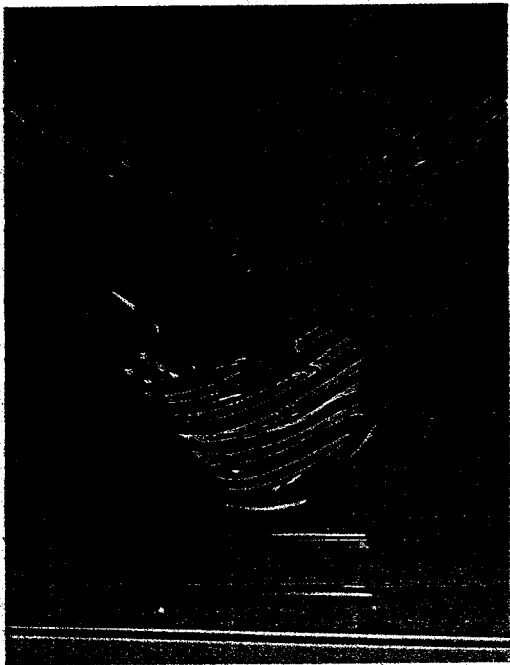

Now positioned in the trophy shelf is the award received last month for the Greendale 'SAL squad's 100% membership retention.

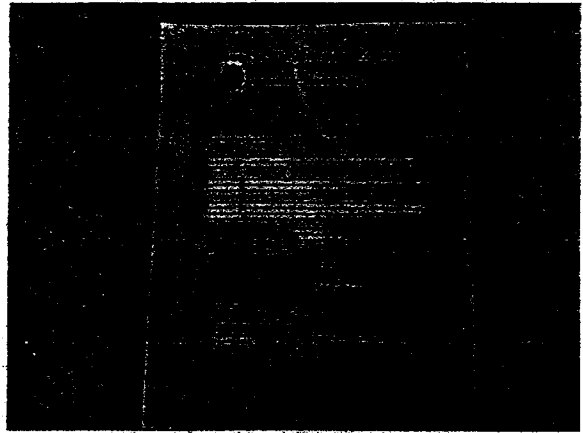
Financial report - Expect more revenue coming in soon with dues and sales of placemat ads

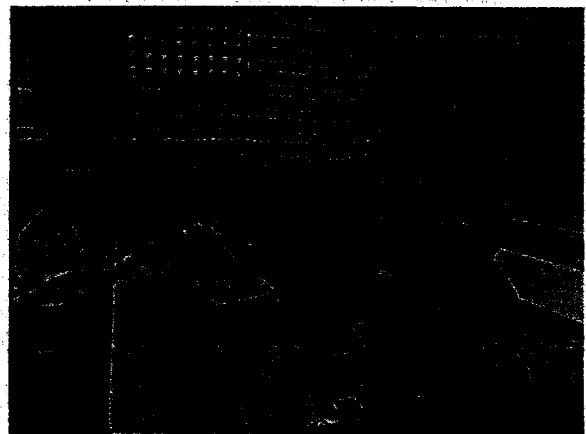
The toy box has been replenished and Dave Bauer checks on it regularly. He notes that few Legion Hall events with children is hurting sales.
