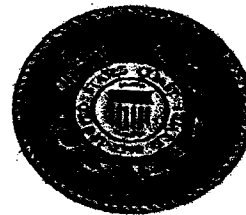
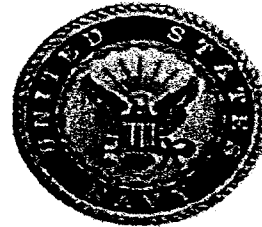

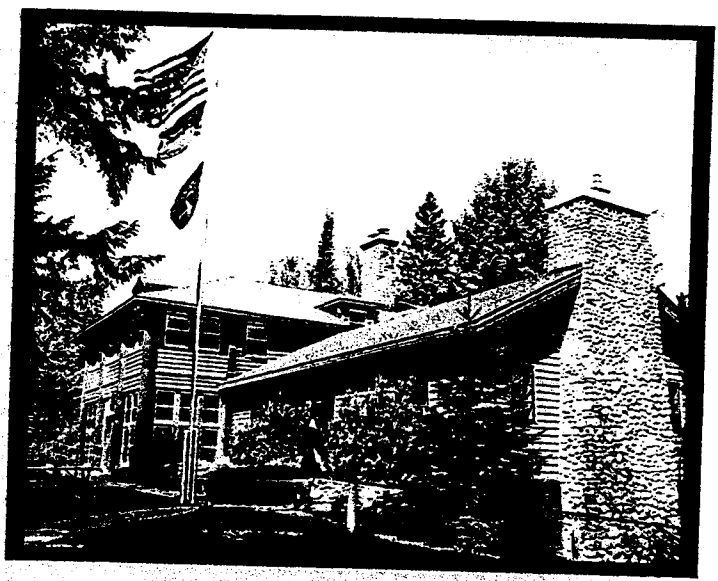
Wisconsin residents who are currently serving, honorably discharged from the military or a Family of the Fallen.
