Score Hoops 3on3 Basketball League Rules

- 1. "Home team" will shoot from the free throw line to decide who inbounds the ball first. A made free throw results in having possession of the ball. A miss will result in the opposing team having possession first.
- 2. Games are 20-minute running time. There are no time-outs. Short water breaks may be allowed due to heat or a lack of subs.
- 3. Substitutions after made baskets or when there is a dead ball.
- 4. Ball will be inbounded from the half court line.
- 5. Game will be scored by 1 point, 2 points for a "3-pointer".
- 6. After a made basket or foul call, the ball must be inbounded from the half court.
- 7. All held balls will result in teams inbounding the ball from the halfcourt line. There will be a possession arrow to decide who is awarded possession.
- 8. When a defensive rebound, steal, or change of possession occurs, the ball has to be "cleared" outside of the 3- point line before the offensive team can attempt a shot at the basket.
- 9. After a made basket, the team who was just scored maintains possession and inbounds the ball.
- 10. Foul calls are controlled by the referee. Any foul that occurs in the act of shooting results in one (1) free throw for the team that is fouled. If a foul occurs during live action, the ball is dead and will be inbounded by the team who is fouled.
- 11. Intentional fouls (no matter when they occur) will result in 2 points PLUS the ball.
- 12. Players have 5 seconds to shoot a free throw once the teams are lined up.
- 13. No stalling. There will be a ref's discretion 30-second shot clock.
- 14. If there is a tie after regulation, there will be a free throw shootout. Team who inbounded the ball to begin the game will shoot first. If that team makes the free throw, the opposing team gets an opportunity to make a free throw. If the 2nd team misses they lose, if the 2nd team makes the free throw, there is another round of free throws. If all players from each team have gotten a chance to attempt a free throw, "sudden death" occurs and the team that makes the next free throw wins the game.
