Entry Fees



\$75 per event until September 12th 2023

Lift tickets for downhill will be available at the resort ticket booth

- \$35 per day
- \$90 for Thursday through Sunday



Waivers

All racers will be required to fill out a waiver during the online registration process.

If all accompanying waivers are not signed the rider will not be allowed to practice or race until said waivers are signed.



Timing

All riders racing any event will be given a number plate at packet pickup. This plate needs to be secured to the front of the handlebars with the numbers facing forward.

All riders racing in gravity events will be given an active timing chip at packet pickup.

Riders racing endurance events will not be given timing chips at packet pickup and passive timing will be used to time all endurance events.

For gravity riders:

- 1. You must wear your timing chip on the top of your RIGHT wrist during the race, you can tighten the strap so the chip stays on top of your wrist.
- 2. Do not wear the timing chip next to a GPS watch or other electronic device.
- 3. After completing your race a race marshall will collect your chip. If you still have a chip at the conclusion of the race please return the chip to timing. If your chip is not returned you will not receive a time.

Riders who withdraw or do not complete the race should return the transponders to the finish. Lost or damaged transponders will be assessed a \$75 replacement fee.







Cancellation Policy

We do not offer refunds on race entries for the 2024 Sunrise Peak Scramble; however, we do offer a race entry transfer option so riders can sell their entry if they can not make the race.

If you would like to transfer your entry please email naucyclingteam@gmail.com and we can assist your transfer. All transfers must be complete by September 10th 2024.



Race License

A USA Cycling race license is required for competitors and can be purchased during the online registration process.

If you currently have a USA Cycling race license you can apply your license when registering for the Sunrise Peak Scramble.

Courses

All course maps will be available to view on Trailforks and the Sunrise Peak Scramble website on Thursday September 12th 2023 at 12:00am.



- Downhill: Downhill will be roughly 2 miles and feature double black, black, and blue difficulty trails.
- Dual Slalom: Dual slalom will be hosted on the Sunrise Park Resort slalom course and is a black difficulty.
- Cross country: Cross country will feature trails of blue difficulty. Race distances will be category dependent and can be found at the Sunrise Peak Scramble bikereg page.
- Short Track: Short track will consist of a road climb and blue difficulty descent. The race will run for 20 minutes plus 2 laps.

Protection Rules



Gravity (Downhill, Dual Slalom): All riders must race with a downhill certified (ASTM F1952) full face helmet. Other protection such as knee/elbow pads and chest protectors are recommended.

Endurance (Cross Country, Short Track): All riders racing endurance events are required to wear a helmet. Full face downhill helmets are not required for endurance events. Other protection such as knee/elbow pads are recommended.



Claims and Penalties?

Riders are not allowed outside the Sunrise Park Resort parking lot and sunrise base area (grass lawn at the start of the lifts) while the resort is closed (After 4:00pm to 8:00 am).

All riders caught outside the base area will have their entry for the Sunrise Peak Scramble pulled and will be asked to leave the race venue.



Course marshals will be situated along the course to monitor for any race violations. Claims regarding the race or rider conflict must be voiced in person to the race director (located in the timing tent) within 30 minutes of the race finish of the last rider.

The Race Director is authorized to give additional penalties that are not listed in the Sunrise Peak Scramble rules on a case by case basis. Remember, we are all here to have fun so be kind!

The race course is the currently established trail. We will ensure the course is taped widely enough to provide ample line choice for all riders. Do not ride off of the course or cut corners. The trail is well defined and corner cutting will result in time penalties.

Emergency Response

If you come upon an injured rider in your race STOP and check they are ok. If you are unable to stop and help the rider, inform the next emergency responder when you reach them.


All riders who stop to help an injured rider will be given a chance to redo their race run.

There will be a medical station at the Sunrise Park Resort base in the ski patrol lodge.

For serious and severe injuries the event may be paused until the course has been deemed safe to resume.

The Sunrise Park Resort ski/bike patrol will be stationed at regular intervals throughout every race course.

Accomodations

Sunrise Park Resort Campground - Tent camping will be available in the Sunrise campground for \$15 per night with no water or restrooms available or for \$35 a night for RV camping with hookups. Dispersed Camping - Dispersed camping options are available near the Sunrise Park Resort. All dispersed camping spots are dry and do not feature water or restrooms.
