The Stewardship Committee would like to host another fair to educate our congregation about the many ways they can use their time, talents, and treasures at St. Michael. The fair will take place in the gym on **September 21st, 2025 at 12:30pm**. A free lunch is provided.



We are asking your group to have a table and display the following:

1. The title of your group (For Example: Board of Stewardship)
 2. What you do or what your purpose in the congregation is. (For Example: To help members find appropriate and meaningful ways to manage their time, talents and treasures in the service of God.)
 3. Ways that members can help or get involved using their TIME TALENTS OR TREASURES (For example: Help set up for the M&M fair, attend a financial/giving session, or talk to Stewardship board members with your ideas)
- Finally, we are asking each group to plan a game because it is going to be a FUN A FAIR. These are some of the following games they used to have back in the day at St. Michaels. If you want to do one of these games please reply to me. It is a first come first serve basis. We don't want 8 cake walks, so early bird gets the worm. (Game Ideas: A cake (or cupcake) walk that played music and kids stopped on the number then the number drawn won a cake; A game to win a gold fish with ping pong balls being thrown into glass jars filled with water. Parents can chose real fish or goldfish crackers.; A jail where students can write down the name of an adult or other kids to be put in jail for 10 seconds.; A haunted house room.; A ring toss onto bottles of pop and they would win that pop.) Or whatever game you come up with! Look online or relate it to your group/activities. (Cemetery board could have a toy lawn mower game?)

Each family that comes will get a passport. You discuss your program with the family, then stamp their pass and allow them to play your game once. At the end, the family turns in their completed passport for prize drawings.
