


Notes From Pastor...

What a great time of year the end of January. As a kid, I can remember Super Bowls being played at this time every year. Basketball season was getting started and also there was snow. Some people dread the snow, perhaps because it is difficult to drive in, but if you took the driving out of it snow is a gift of God.



As you know, I just moved here from southern Indiana, and we had snow, but usually it wasn't for very long. I grew up in Michigan and always loved to see the snow. After living where there isn't much snow for a while, the color of everything being brown makes winter very difficult. It is cold outside, and everything is dull brown or ugly lifeless. Sometimes this is how life is too. Sometimes we see the world as dull brown and lifeless. Things become difficult, because it seems like there is no hope. Online Giving (Kindrid)

REMINDER from the Contribution Coordinator:

St. Michael's offers electronic giving, called Kindrid, which allows you to make donations on a scheduled, automatic basis. If you are writing checks and preparing envelopes every week, you will especially appreciate electronic giving. It also allows members who are unable to attend church, like "snow birds" in Winter, and "up north vacationers" in Summer, to still be able to contribute. It is convenient for you and provides much-needed consistency for our church. Last year, members and non-members, contributed \$162,945 to St. Michaels, with 44 members using the recurring gifts option.

How To Set Up:

To set up electronic donations, go to the St. Michael's webpage, "stmichaelsrichville.org" and scroll down and click on the "I Give Online" button. Once in the Kindrid site, click "Sign In", and scroll down to where it says, "Don't have a giving Account?", and click on "Create one". Create a giving account with your Name, Address, and Email Address. Enter your bank account or credit card information. Choose a recurring donation (weekly or monthly) or a onetime donation. Once your account is open, you can select which fund(s) to donate to. The regular funds like Home Purpose, Missions, Capital Improvement, New Construction, and Church Technology, are available, but so are all the Endowment Funds and other various funds to select. There is also a new optional button to check if you want to pay an additional 2.5%, to help offset the processing fees.

If you need help or if you have questions, please contact Mark Schoenow (989) 751-4910, and I can walk you right through the process. Attached is a QR barcode that can be scanned to enter Kindrid.



You look for the best in the others you see










SNOW TUBING
