MELT THE SAINTS

Oliver Cromwell (1599 –1658) was an English military and political leader who ruled the Commonwealth of England, Scotland, and Ireland from 1653 to 1658. During his reign there was a shortage of currency in the British Empire. On his order, representatives searched the nation to find silver to meet the demand. After a month, the team reported that the only silver they found were the statues of saints in the cathedrals. When he heard this, Oliver Cromwell ordered: "Melt down the saints and put them into circulation."



SAINTS IN CIRCULATION

Today we come to **Romans 12:9-21**, where we are given 25 instructions on what living like Christ looks like. It is as if Paul was saying: "Melt the saints and put them in circulation.

This whole section is sandwiched between two instructions that summarize the whole:

"Let love be genuine...
Do not be overcome with evil,
but overcome evil with good."
(Rm.12:9a and 21)

multitude of sins.






Here is what love looks like in action...

IT WILL GET BETTER!


Romans 12:12b

Romans 12:16b

16 ...Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly.

Don't think you are better than everybody else!





DON'T TOOT YOUR OWN HORN!

Romans 12:16c

16 ...Never be wise in your own sight.

Resist the tendency to over-value yourself and under-value others.



I ONLY GIVE CHANGE IN LOVE!

Romans 12:17a

17 Repay no one evil for evil.

Kindness is the only currency I carry!

Romans 12:19


19 Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord."

ROMANS 12:9-21 (THE MESSAGE)

9-10 Love from the center of who you are; don't fake it. Run for dear life from evil; hold on for dear life to good. Be good friends who love deeply; practice playing second fiddle.

11-13 Don't burn out; keep yourselves fueled and aflame. Be alert servants of the Master, cheerfully expectant. Don't quit in hard times; pray all the harder. Help needy Christians; be inventive in hospitality.

ROMANS 12:9-21 (THE MESSAGE)

14-16 Bless your enemies; no cursing under your breath. Laugh with your happy friends when they're happy; share tears when they're down. Get along with each other; don't be stuck-up. Make friends with nobodies; don't be the great somebody.

17-19 Don't hit back; discover beauty in everyone. If you've got it in you, get along with everybody. Don't insist on getting even; that's not for you to do. "I'll do the judging," says God. "I'll take care of it."

ROMANS 12:9-21 (THE MESSAGE)

²⁰⁻²¹ Our Scriptures tell us that if you see your enemy hungry, go buy that person lunch, or if he's thirsty, get him a drink. Your generosity will surprise him with goodness.

Don't let evil get the best of you; get the best of evil by doing good.
