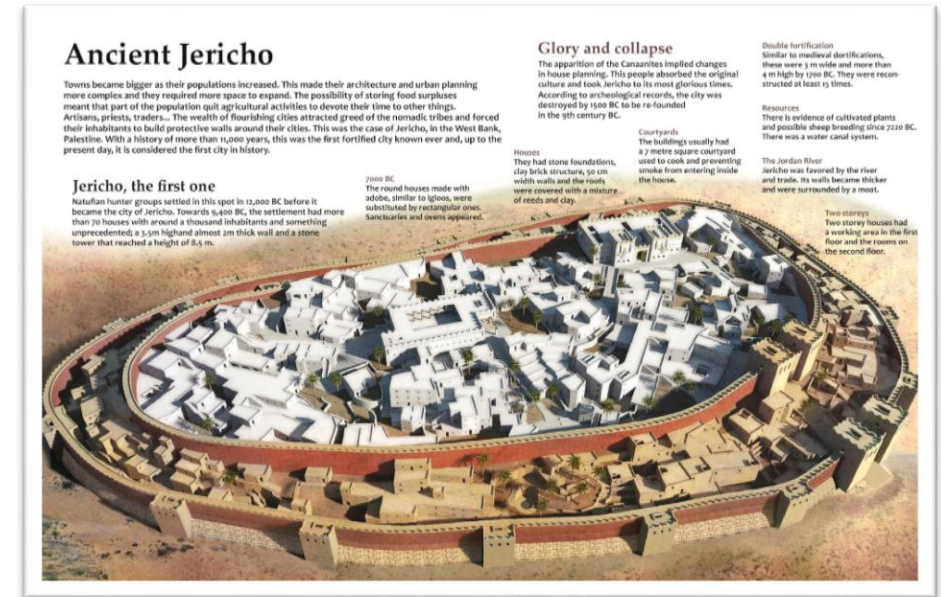
We live in times of

Walls, Watchmen, and Trumpets

In Biblical times, major cities would be surrounded by a wall for protection.

The wall would have several gates, all around the city. These gates would be open during the day and closed at night. The gates would have different names to identify them based on their function and the neighborhood they were in.



Walls, Watchmen, and Trumpets

At different places on the wall, the king would place men to watch for invading armies and other dangers. They were called “watchmen”.

In times of danger, they would warn the people by blowing a horn. Different sounds would mean different things. So it was imperative that the watchman blow his trumpet clearly!

¹⁷ Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel. Whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me.

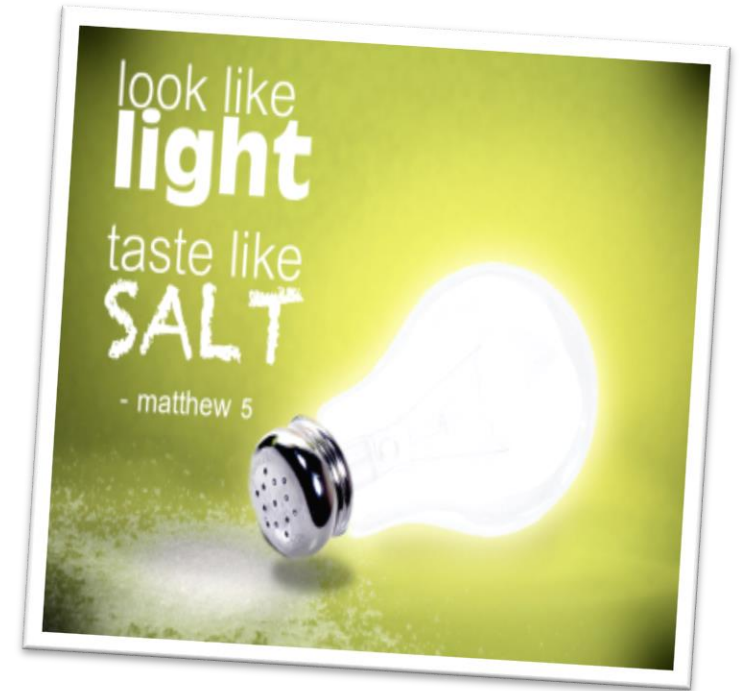

Rachel Anne Dolezal^{[pron 1][fn 1]} (born November 12, 1977), also known as **Nkechi Amare Diallo**,^{[pron 2][fn 1]} is an American woman known for identifying and [passing](#) as a [black woman](#) while being white and having no verifiable African ancestry. She is a former college instructor and [National Association for the Advancement of Colored People](#) (NAACP) chapter president.

Dolezal was president of the NAACP chapter in [Spokane, Washington](#), from 2014 until June 2015, when she resigned in the midst of controversy over her racial identity. She received public scrutiny when her white parents publicly stated that she was passing as [black](#). The statement by Dolezal's parents followed Dolezal's reports to police and local news media that she had been the victim of race-related [hate crimes](#).^{[8][9][10]} however, a subsequent police investigation had failed to substantiate her allegations.^[11] Dolezal had also identified herself as mixed-race on an application and had claimed that an African-American man was her

California Paves Way for 'Nonbinary' Birth Certificates

California is the first state to allow "nonbinary" gender markers on birth certificates and the second, behind Oregon, to allow them on driver's licenses.

California became the first state in the nation to allow "nonbinary" gender markers on birth certificates when Governor Jerry Brown signed [SB 179, or the Gender Recognition Act](#), into law last week. The Golden State is also the second in the country, behind Oregon, to allow residents to be identified by a gender marker other than "F" or "M" on their driver's licenses.

The legislation, authored by Democratic Senators Toni Atkins of San Diego and Scott Wiener of San Francisco, allows residents who identify as "nonbinary" (someone whose gender identity is neither male nor female) or intersex to select a third gender marker on state-issued identification documents. It also makes it easier for those residents to obtain IDs that accurately reflect their gender.

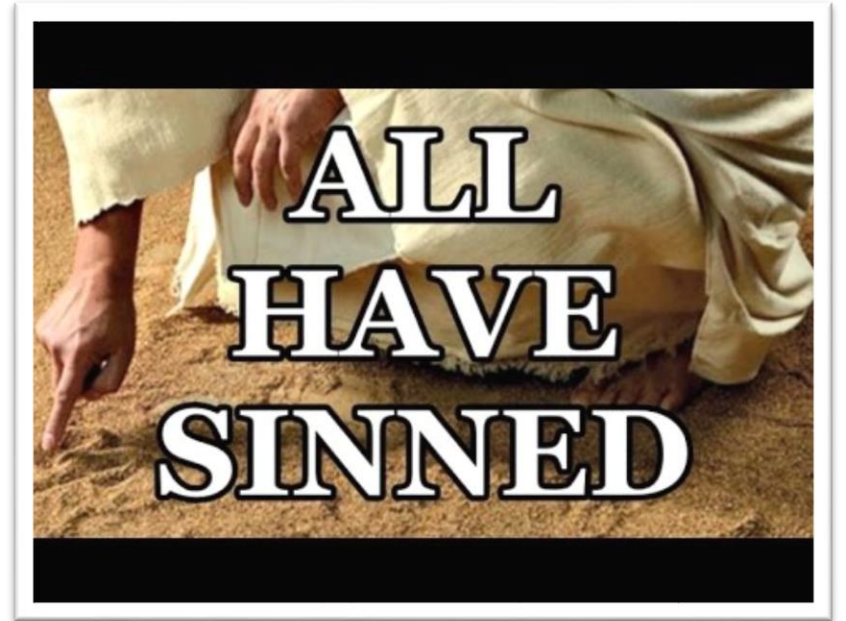
