When did this all this happen?

Genesis 26:1<sup>a</sup> Now there was a famine in the land, besides the former famine that was in the days of Abraham.



# The righteous flourish...

In the middle of a famine, Isaac didn't simply survive. He thrived!

## Psalm 32:12-15 <sup>12</sup> The righteous flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar in Lebanon. <sup>13</sup> They are



planted in the house of the Lord; they flourish in the courts of our God. <sup>14</sup> They still bear fruit in old age; they are ever full of sap and green, <sup>15</sup> to declare that the Lord is upright; he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him. God does not depend on circumstances! In times of "famine" we remind ourselves that God is still God!

#### Genesis 26:12

<sup>12</sup> And Isaac sowed **in that land** and reaped in the same year a hundredfold.

Where did this happen?

Genesis 26:1<sup>b</sup> ...And Isaac went to Gerar to Abimelech king of the Philistines. <sup>6</sup> So Isaac settled in Gerar.



Even in Gerar... Gerar was one of the 5 main cities of Philistia, the land of the Philistines.

Abraham had been here a generation before. Here he failed by cowardly lying by saying that Sarah was his sister to save his life (Gn. 20).

Here, Isaac repeated his father's failure (Gn.26:6-11).


# Psalm 35:27
