IASS questions the breach of confidentiality of its members at the Council of Commissioners meeting

Many members have denounced the inappropriate methods used by representatives of Local 800 in their campaign to raid members of our Union. These methods include violating the basic rules of civility and privacy and using arrogant language to convince our members to move on to Local 800. This behavior has culminated by the non-authorized and illegal use of personal information relating to the members, such as their email addresses, their private telephone numbers and their civic addresses.

Having received complaints from members last June, the IASS has sent a formal complaint to the LBPSB asking that an investigation take place regarding the leak of private information and what steps are being taken to prevent such a situation from happening again.

Although follow ups with the Board were made on their investigation, Allison Provost, President of the IASS, addressed the subject in front of the Council of Commissioners during their meeting that was held on August 29th. The Council assured us that they share the members concerns, that the investigation was ongoing and that we would be informed of the results.
