Annual review and target setting

Whilst it is the right of the Headteacher to have their performance appraised, it is also incumbent on governors to hold them to account through a rigorous and independent annual process. The QAE appraisal package ensures that both can happen effectively and efficiently. The annual review process undertaken by QAE involves the following tasks:

- Gathering, analysing and summarising evidence supplied by the headteacher, in advance of the meeting
- Presenting the information to governors, alongside the Headteacher
- Quantifying the impact of the work completed and supporting governors to reach a judgement regarding the extent to which targets have been met
- Making recommendations to governors regarding pay, whilst ensuring they undertake all of their statutory duties around appraisal
- Agreeing and setting targets for the coming year, following discussion and analysis

Support for mid-year review

For an additional fee, we can support governors and the Headteacher to review the evidence already gained through the first half of the appraisal year. This includes quantifying progress against the targets, agreeing where further evidence will be needed to meet the objectives by the end of the cycle and ensuring that the wellbeing of the Headteacher is appropriately monitored and supported. An effective mid-year review with QAE assures those involved in the appraisal process that progress against targets is on track and that there is a clear pathway to achieving them fully at the end of the appraisal cycle.

Curriculum review

Do you need a fresh pair of eyes on your curriculum? Perhaps you are wanting to ensure that your curriculum meets the scope and ambition of the national curriculum, or you want to check the extent to which learning builds in sequences of lessons?

Our one-day review will quickly establish the strengths of your intended curriculum and establish any areas which might require more work. The review uses the grade descriptors from the Education Inspection Framework as a basis for this work.

In advance of the visit day, we will take a look at a sample of maths, reading and writing planning, alongside that of 3 foundation subjects.

The visit day starts with a meeting with leaders; to understand the aims and ambitions of the curriculum you have in place and then transfers to the classroom where we check out the implementation of those plans. All through the process, leaders are encouraged to engage in candid discussions with the reviewer.

The second part of the review looks at planning in 3 foundation subjects, which are chosen by leaders. Again, we meet with curriculum leaders and check out the implementation of the curriculum in the classroom.

Following this, the final part of the review entails a detailed, verbal report of the findings and any subsequent recommendations. This is accompanied by a written summary report following the review.

SEND Review

We are all agreed that the challenges of providing high-quality education for SEND pupils is a hugely challenging aspect of school leadership. Championing the education of potentially the most vulnerable pupils is essential for a successful school. Our thorough SEND review will help you evaluate your provision and provide clear actions that you can take to further your offer.

Throughout the review, we will focus our attention on the intent, implementation and impact of your SEND provision, challenging your thinking, evaluating the effectiveness of your plans and assessing how effectively they are implemented.

Pupil Premium Review

Governance Review

Safeguarding Audit

It is incumbent on schools to ensure that the safeguarding of children is a culture, a non-negotiable expectation and responsibility. However, this comes with challenges, due to the high-stakes nature of this obligation.

We will work with you during an audit to understand and evaluate the procedures and processes you have in place to meet the statutory obligations of safeguarding, plus further evaluate what you do beyond these requirements to ensure that safeguarding really is everyone's responsibility.

As part of the one-day audit, we will conduct a thorough review of the reporting of concerns and record keeping processes, undertake a Single Central Record check, review policy and website compliance and check the appropriateness of your risk assessing. We will evaluate the scope and impact of staff training, check the PSHE curriculum relating to keeping safe and healthy, listen to your pupil and staff views as well as working with governors to ensure they fulfil their duties also.

At the end of the review, the school will receive immediate verbal feedback, followed shortly afterwards by a clear, simple summary report, RAG rating the findings and suggesting areas for further development. This will help leaders develop a subsequent action plan.

Developmental Review
