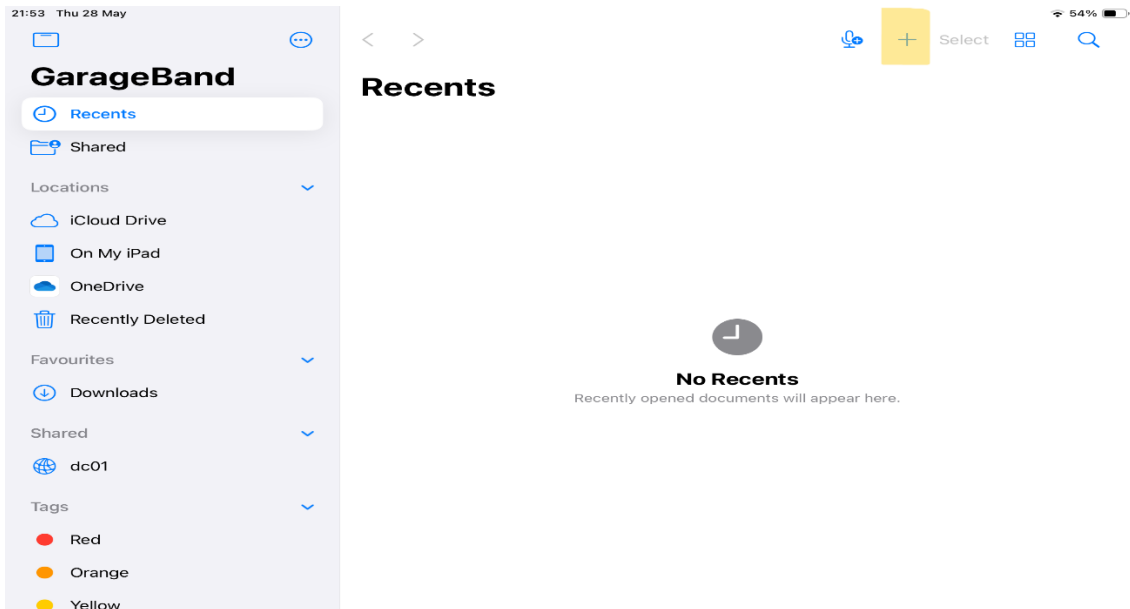


MUSIC MAESTRO PRIMARY

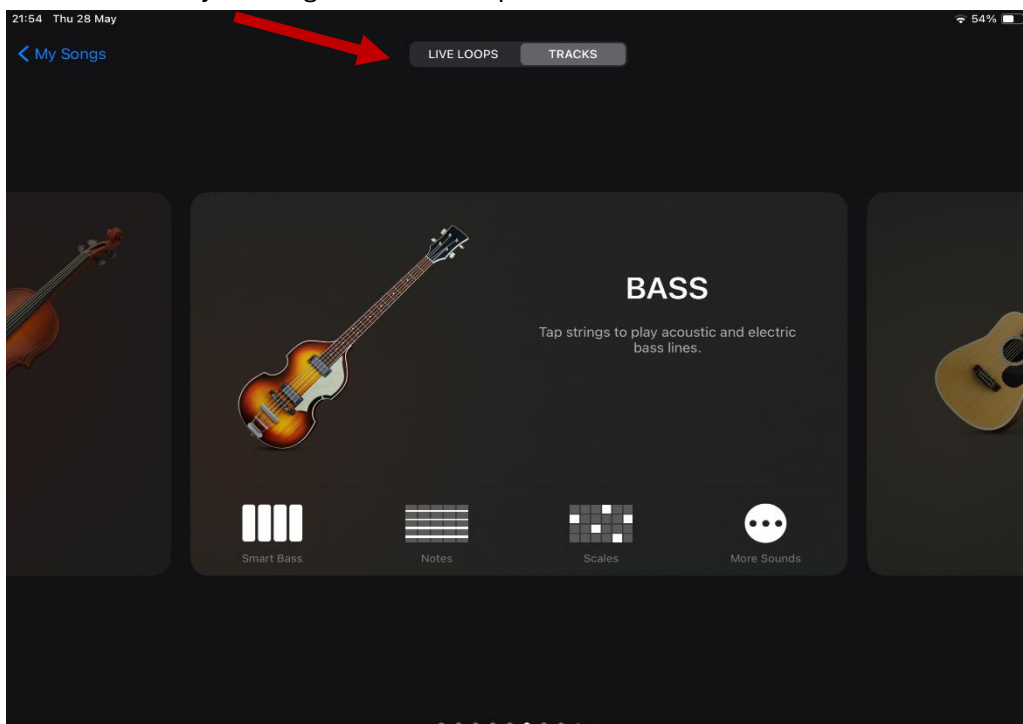
Garage band key screens.

1. How to start a new project.

Click the '+' icon which takes you to the instrument list page.

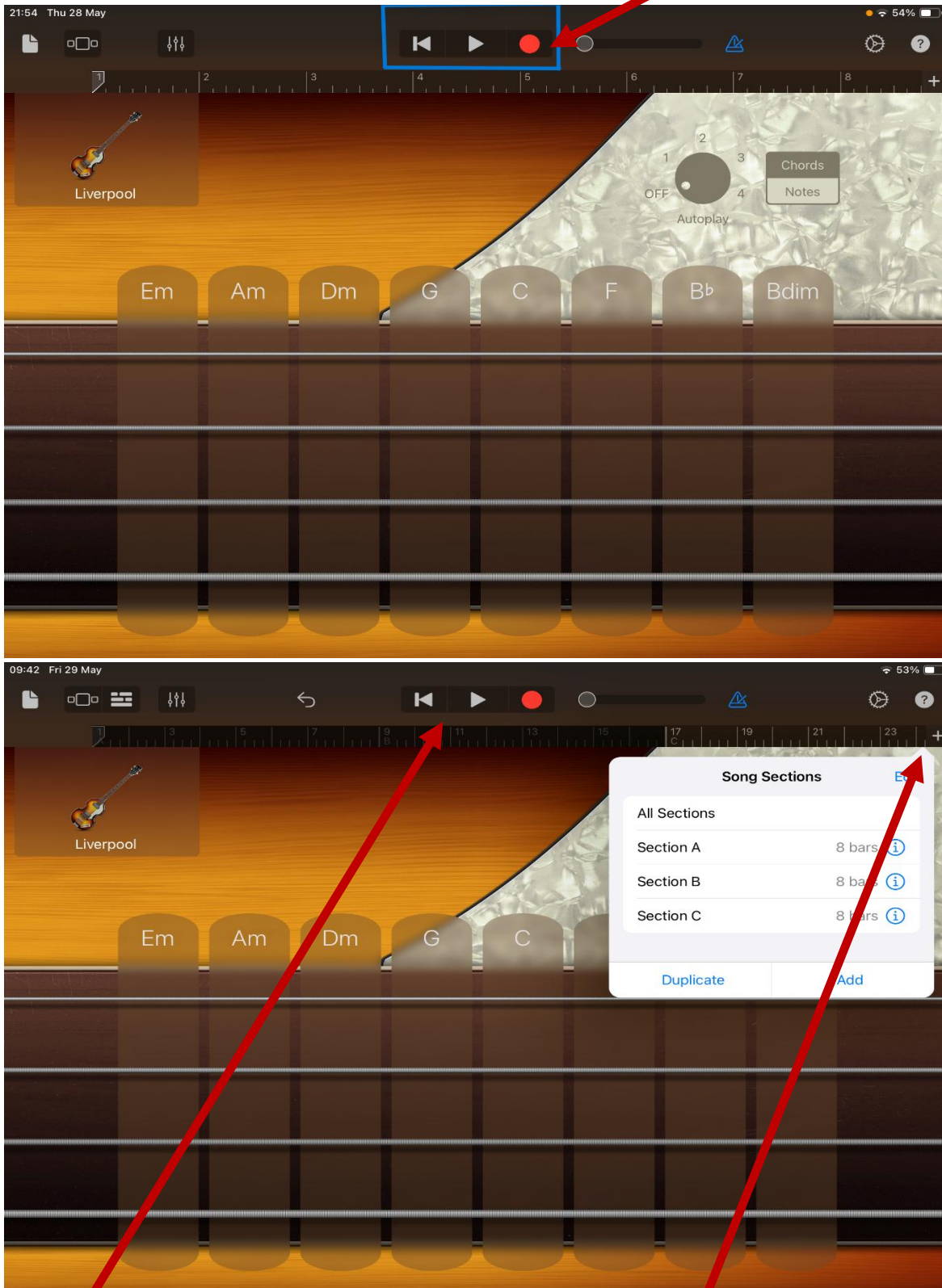


2. This is the main instrument page. Swipe across to see all the available instruments. Later in the scheme you will be asked to open loops. When you move onto this part you can find them by clicking on the live loops tab.

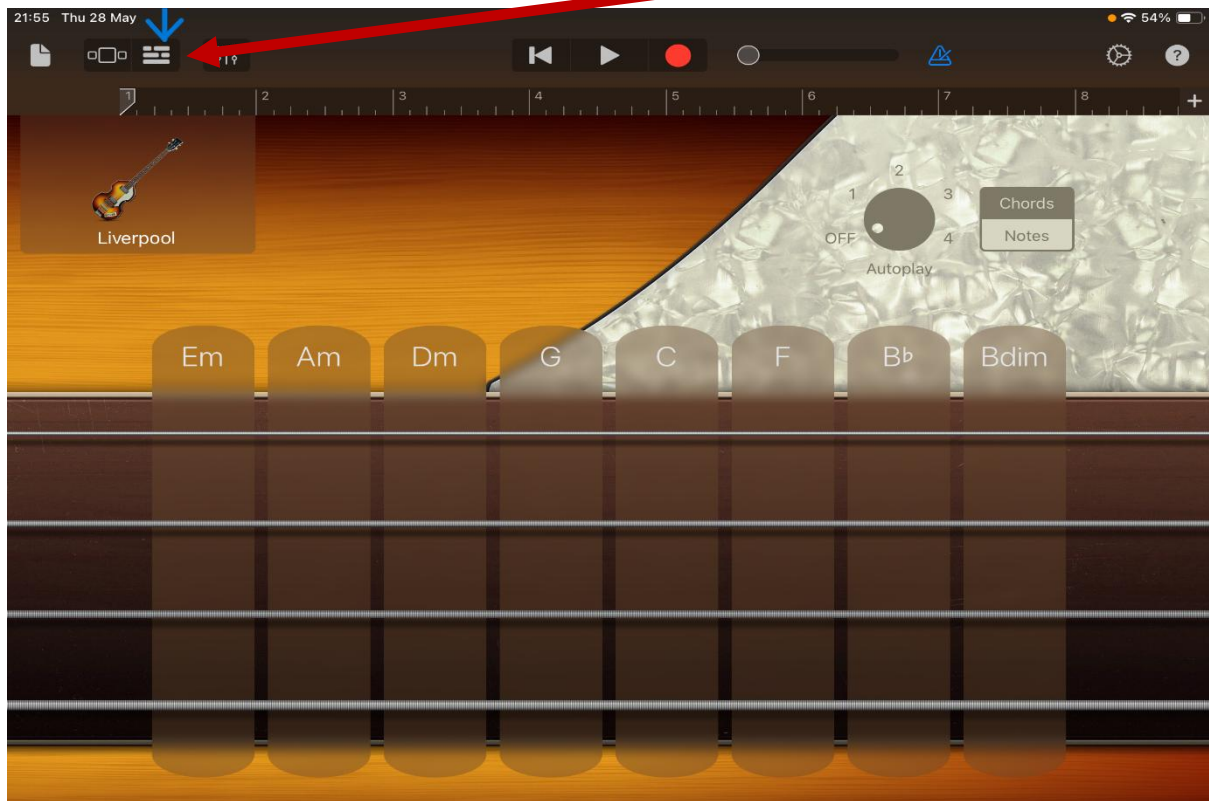
- An example of an open instrument page, the record button is the red circle. It will give a countdown of 4 before the recording starts.



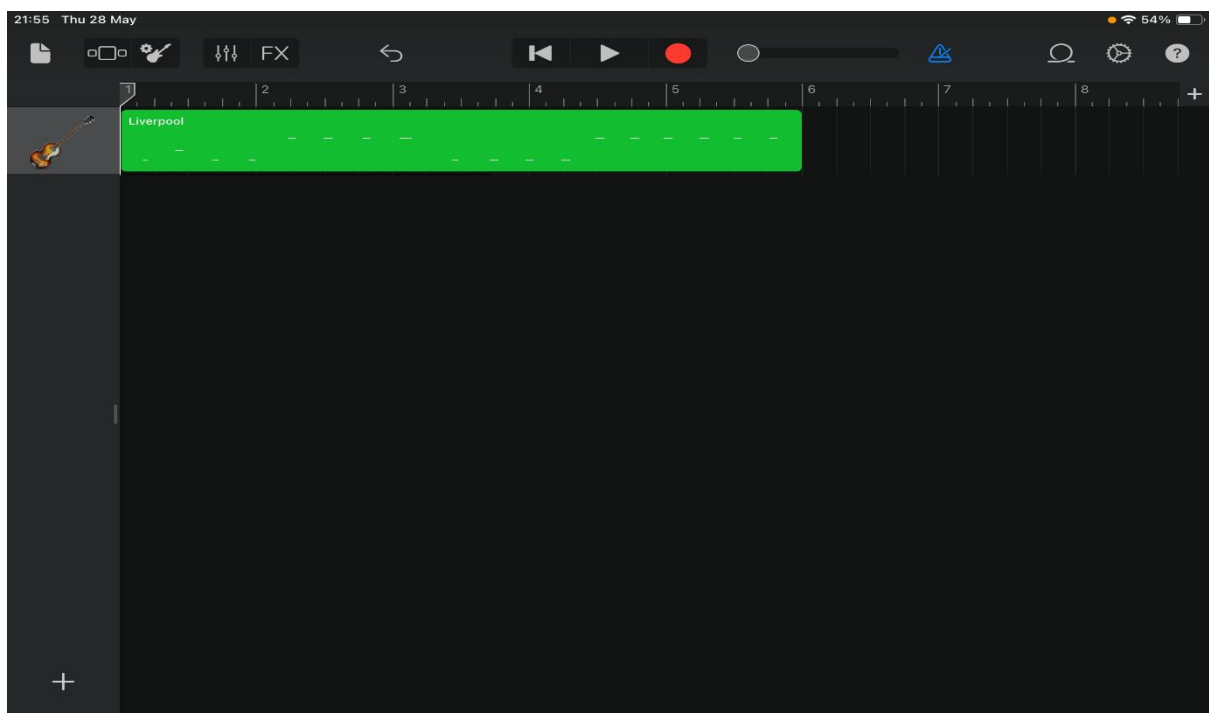
The playback button is the triangle. If you need to add more bars - which will help create the sections - click on the '+' and add sections as you need. 8 bars per section is ideal.

4. When you have recorded a section of music you can click [here](#) to find the track list.

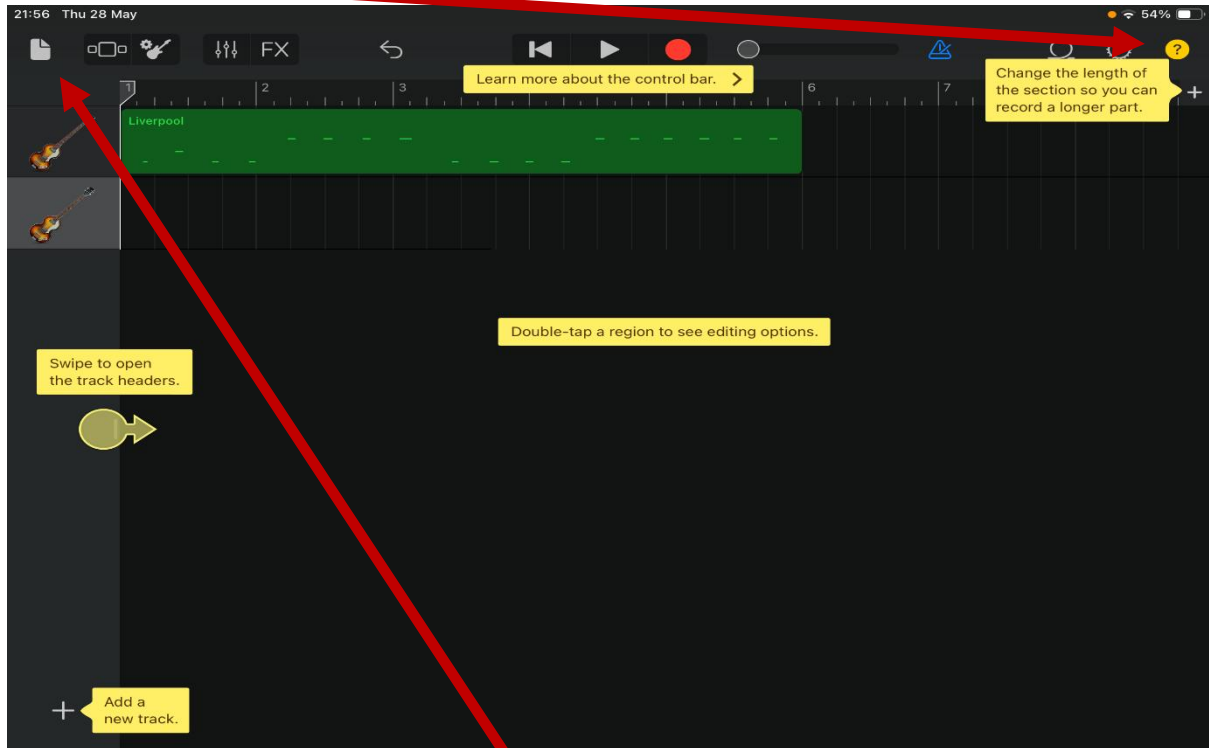


It will take you to this page. Every time you add a new track it will appear here.

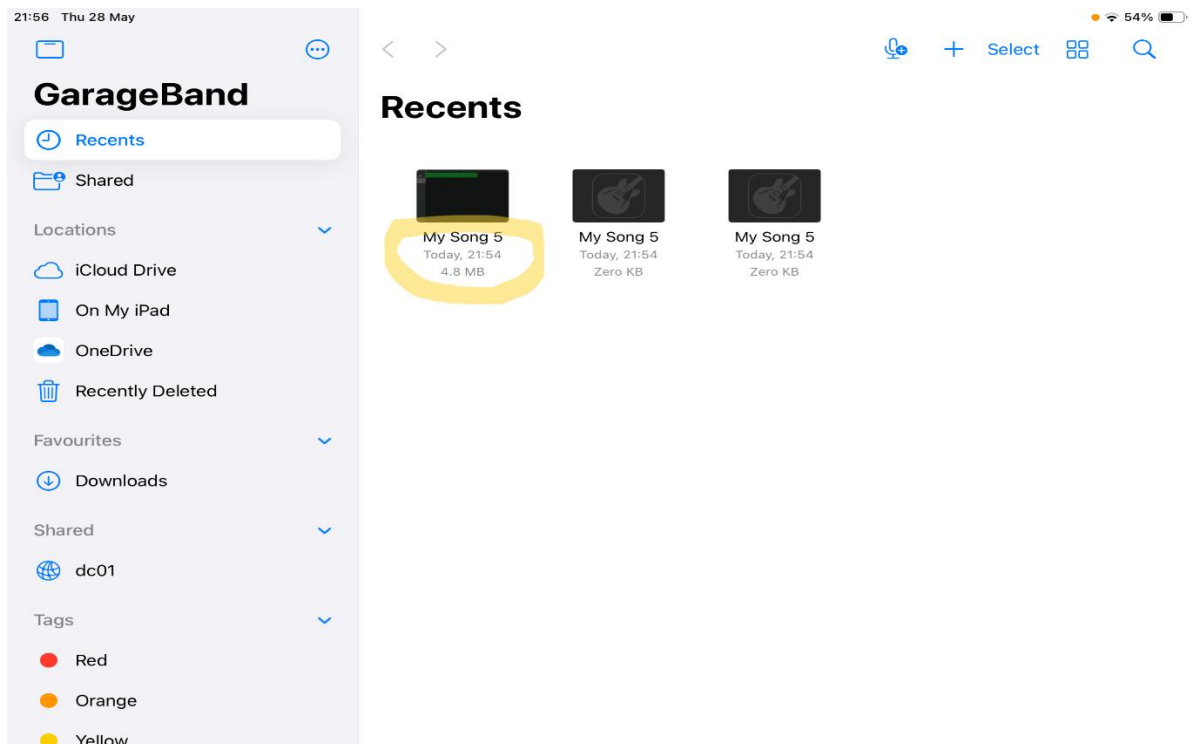

5. The '?' button will give some quick links to help with any issues.



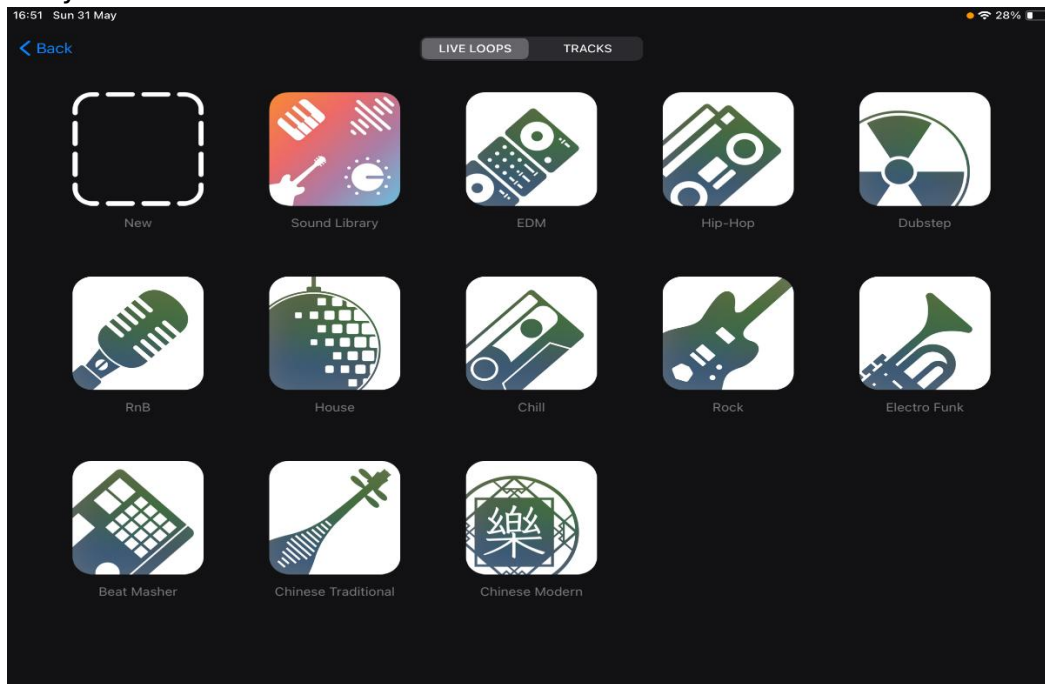
6. To save work, click on the page icon, which takes you to the page below. Click on the words below and change it to name and date so that the children can easily find their work.



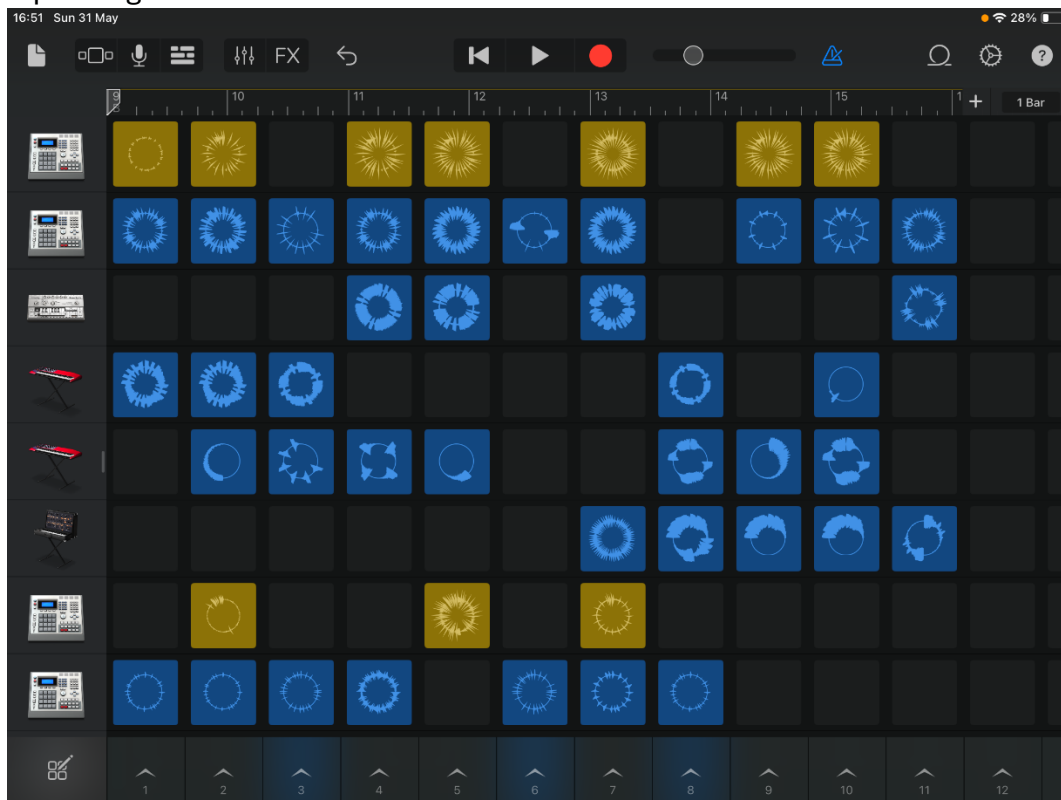
MUSIC MAESTRO PRIMARY

Opening Loops.

Click the live loops icon and it will bring you to this page, select the loop genre you want to try.

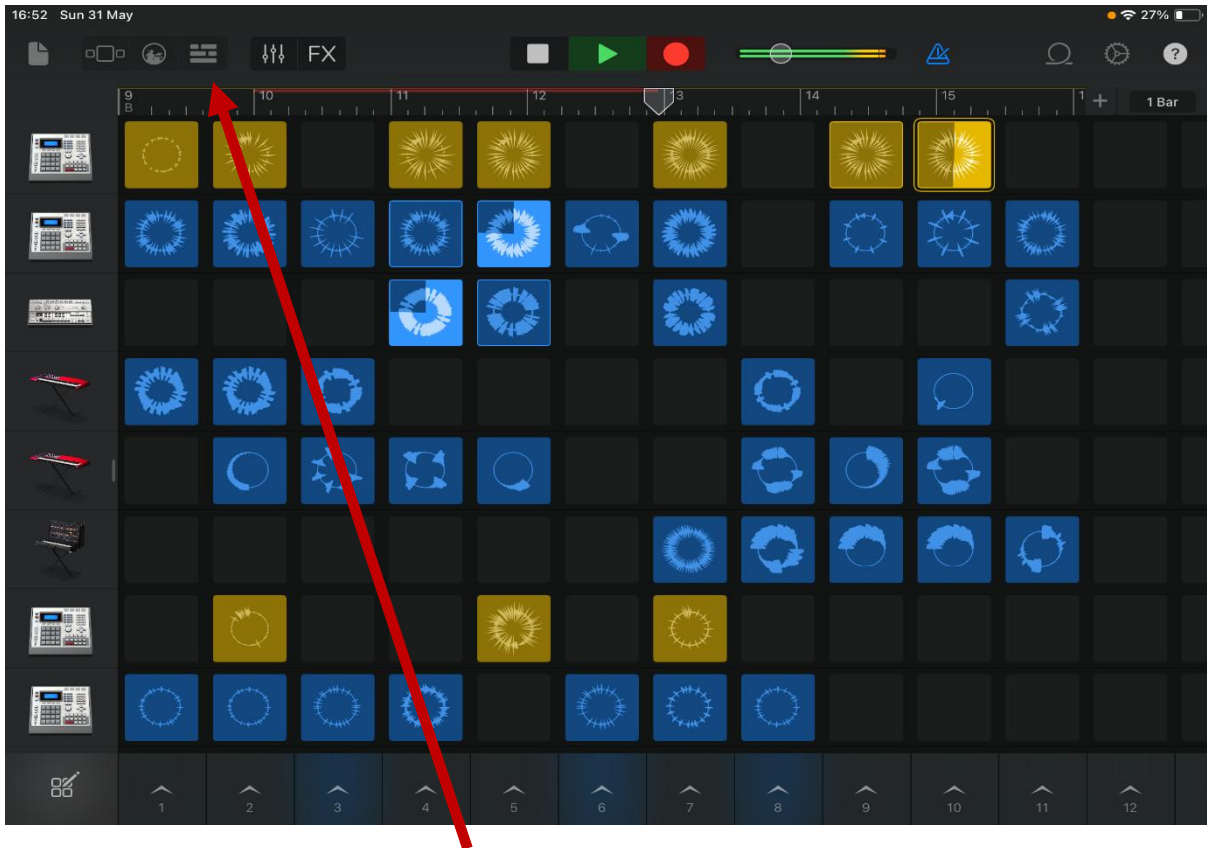


It will open a page with lots of squares. Click on any individual square to open the sound loop. You can click as many as you want and if you change your mind click on the square again to turn it off.

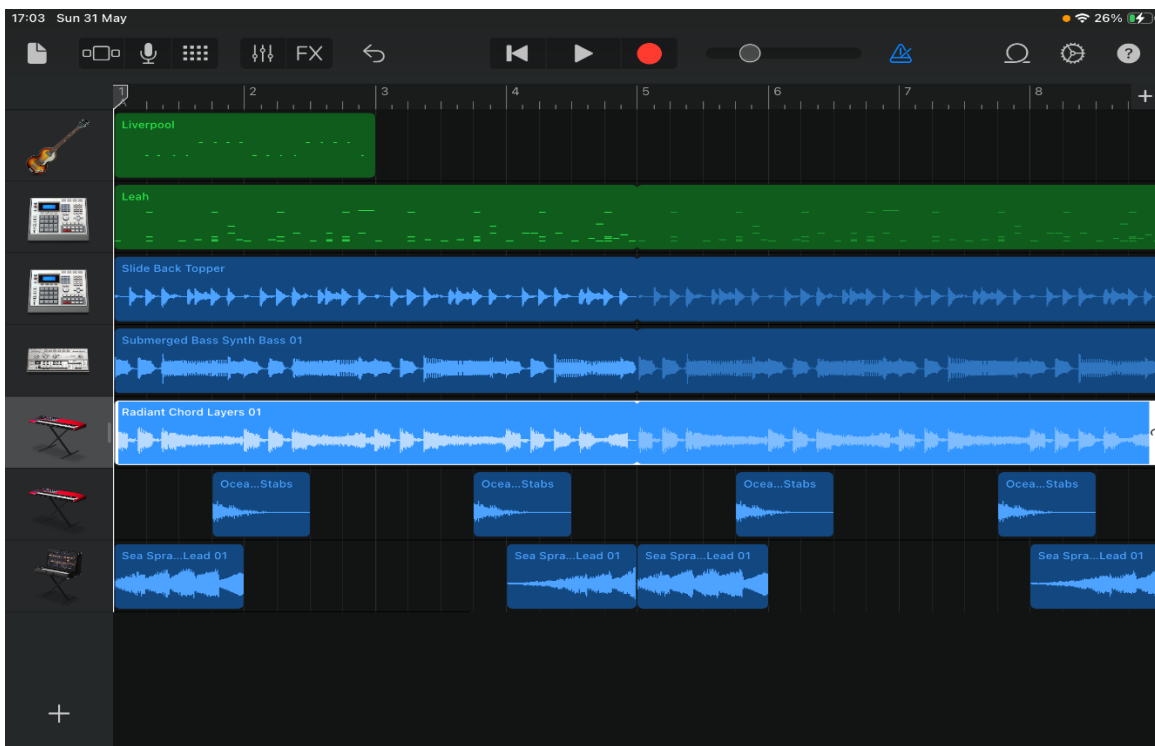

When you have chosen the loops you want to use, click on the stop square, take it back to the beginning (Triangle and line button which appears after you have used the stop button) and push the record button. (Red circle)

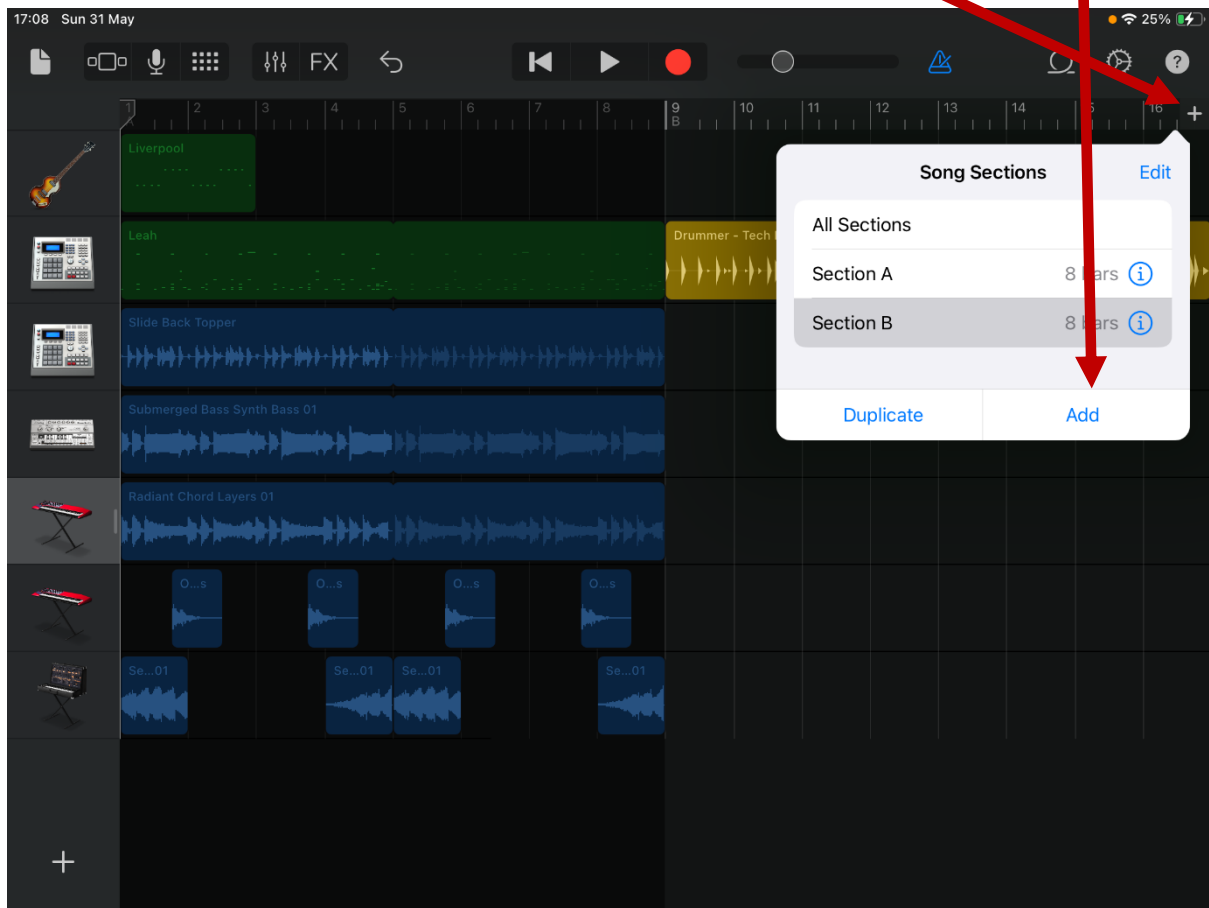


You will then push the track listing button and find your recording.

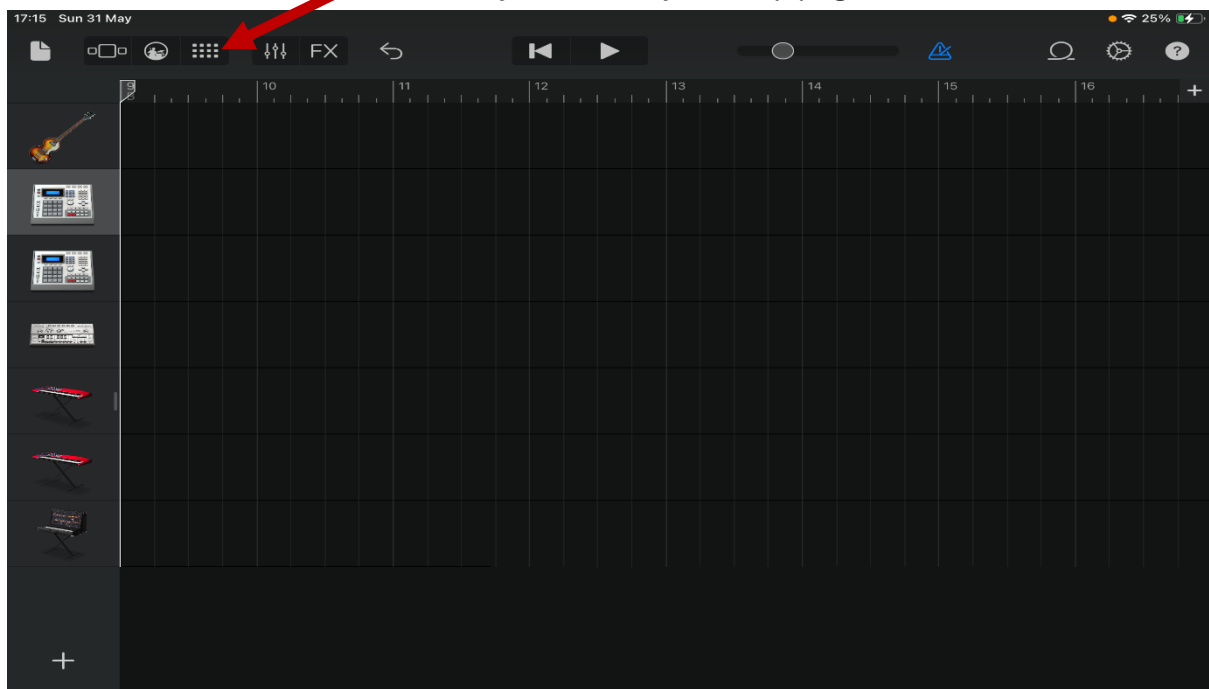

To create a second section, click on the plus button on the right and then the add button. This will automatically add another 8-bar section.

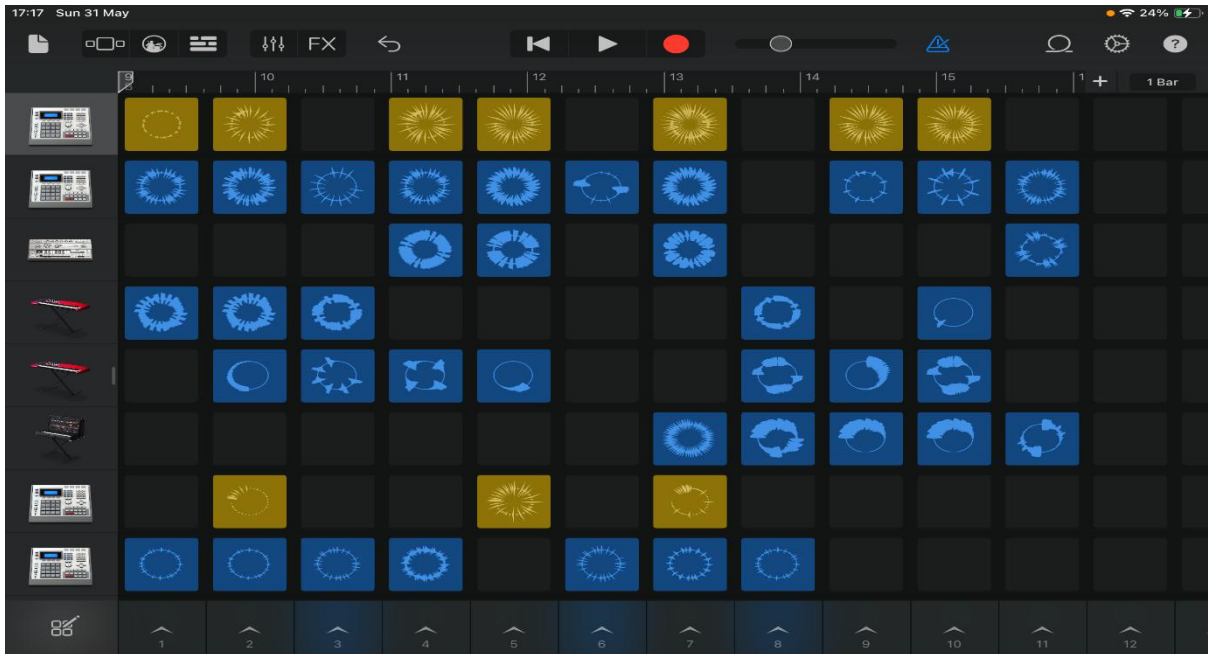


Once the white information tab has disappeared, swipe the page left to see your new 2nd section. Click on this button to take you back to your loop page.

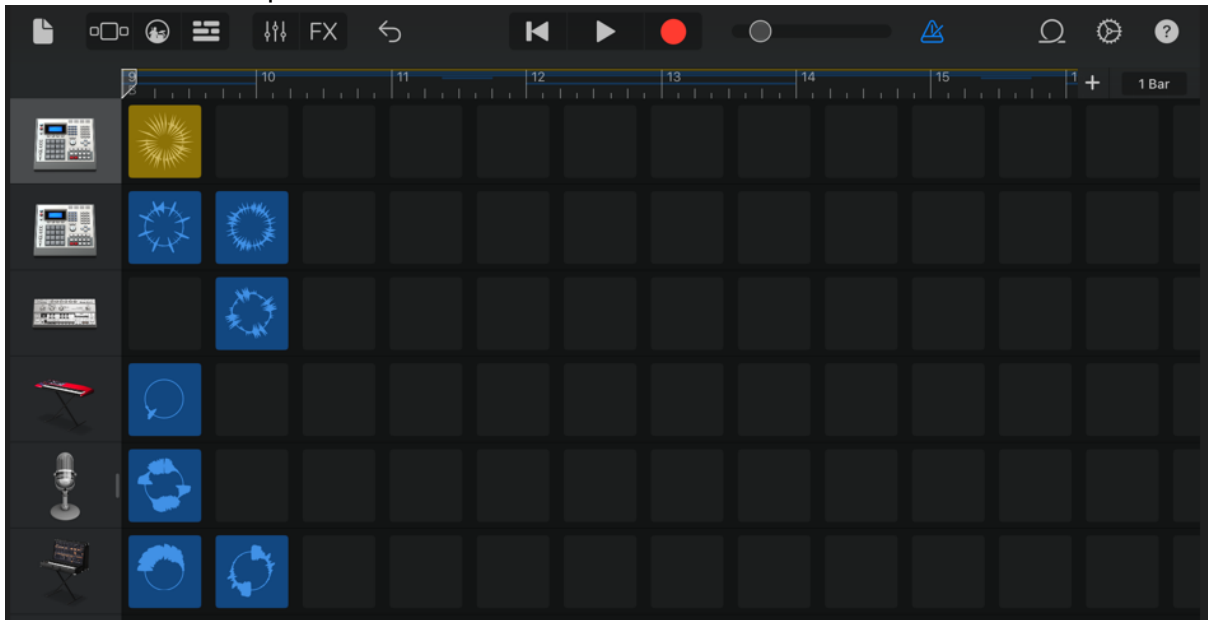


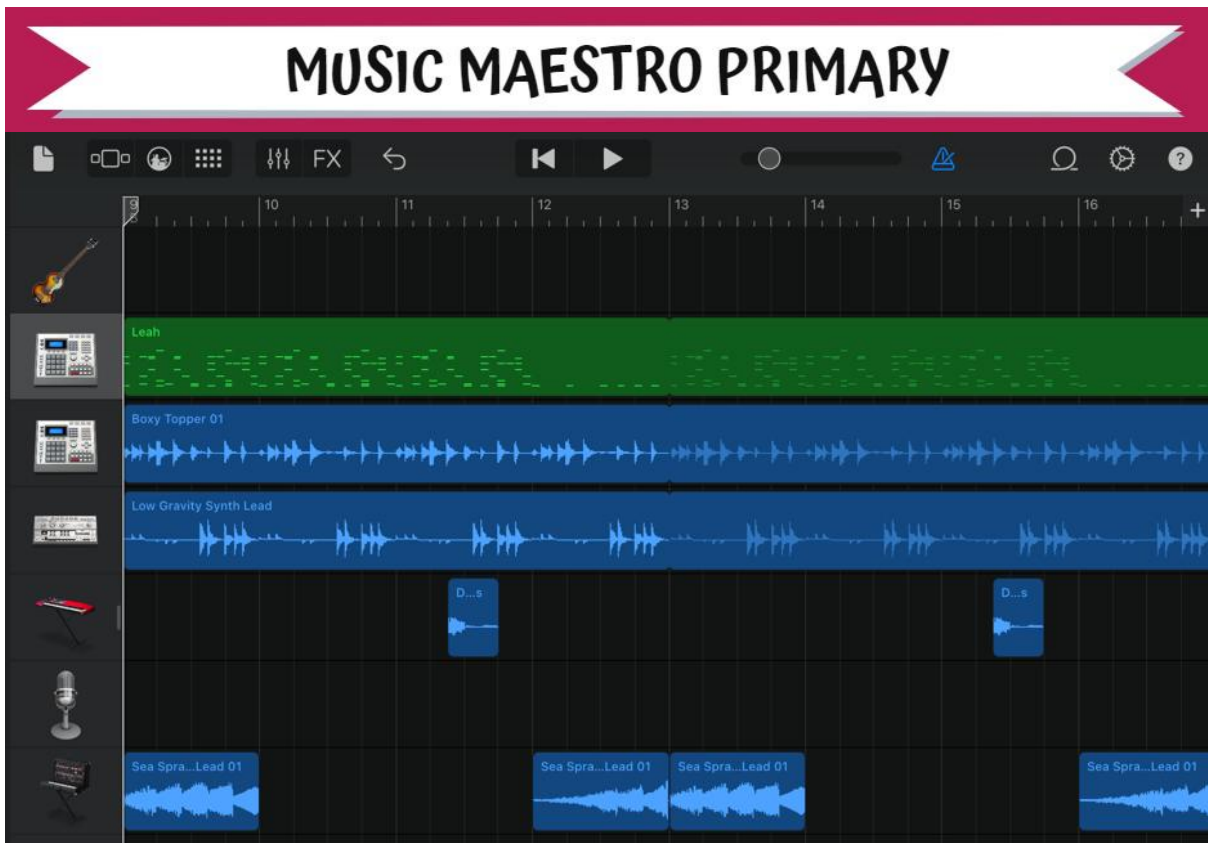

You can then repeat the process of clicking on squares to make a slightly different loop from your first section.

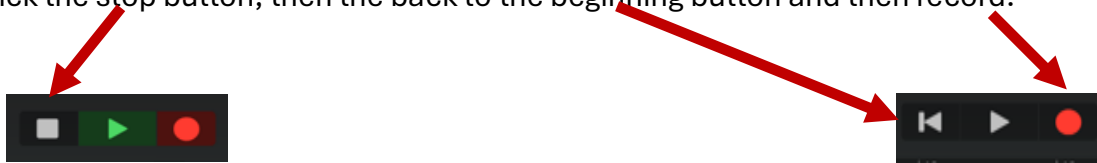


Don't worry if when you come to record the second section there are only a few squares. The sounds will loop to fill the whole 8 bars.

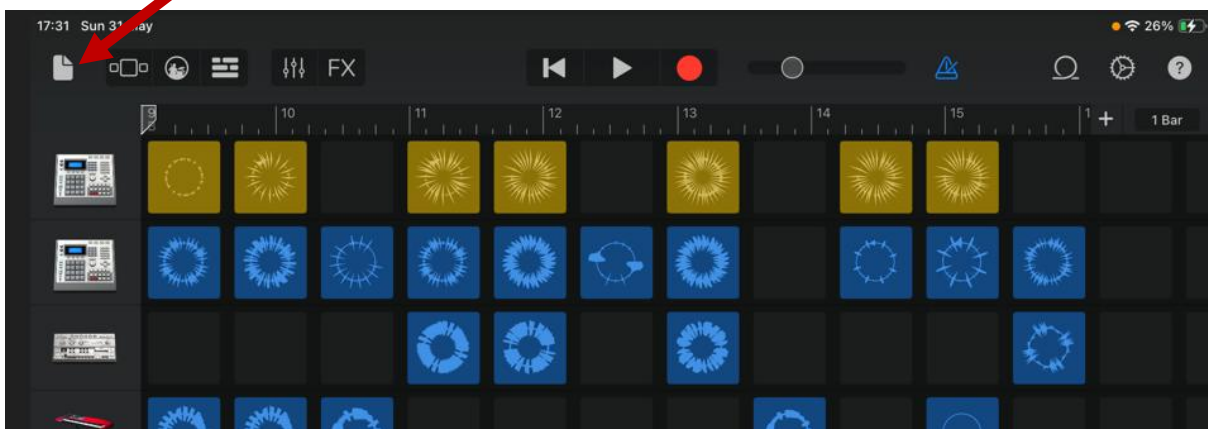




Once you have completed this, record in the same way as previously. Click the stop button, then the back to the beginning button and then record.

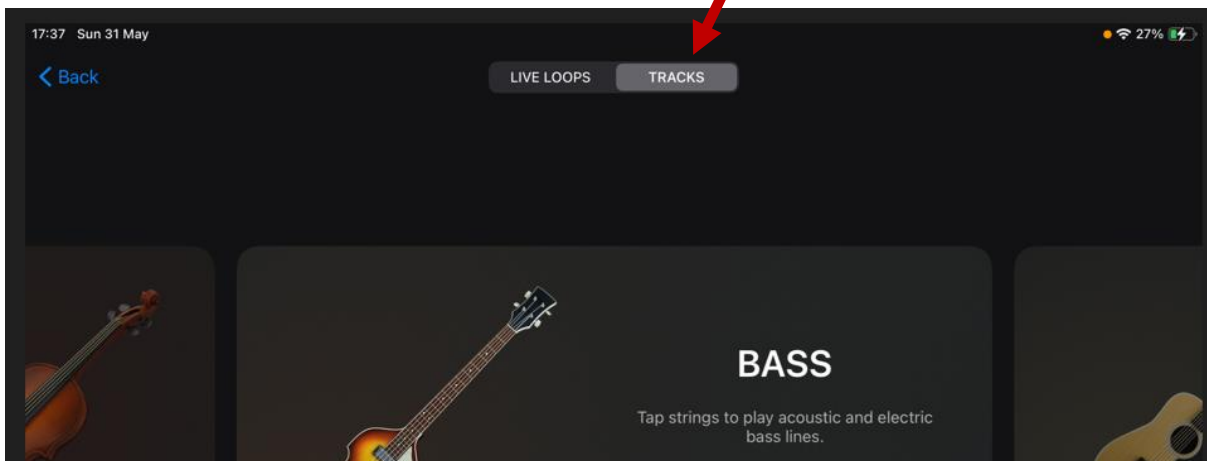
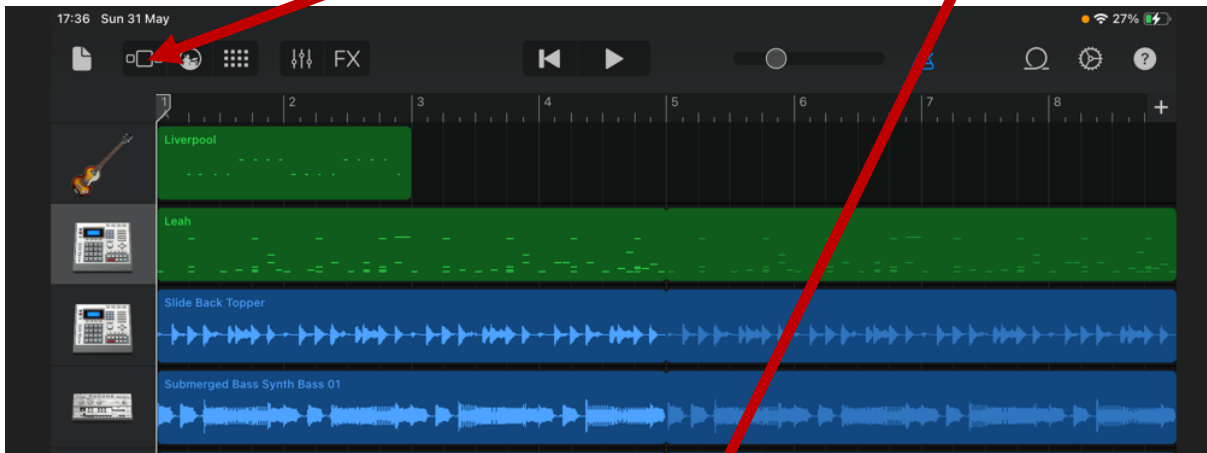


Click the page button to save your work.



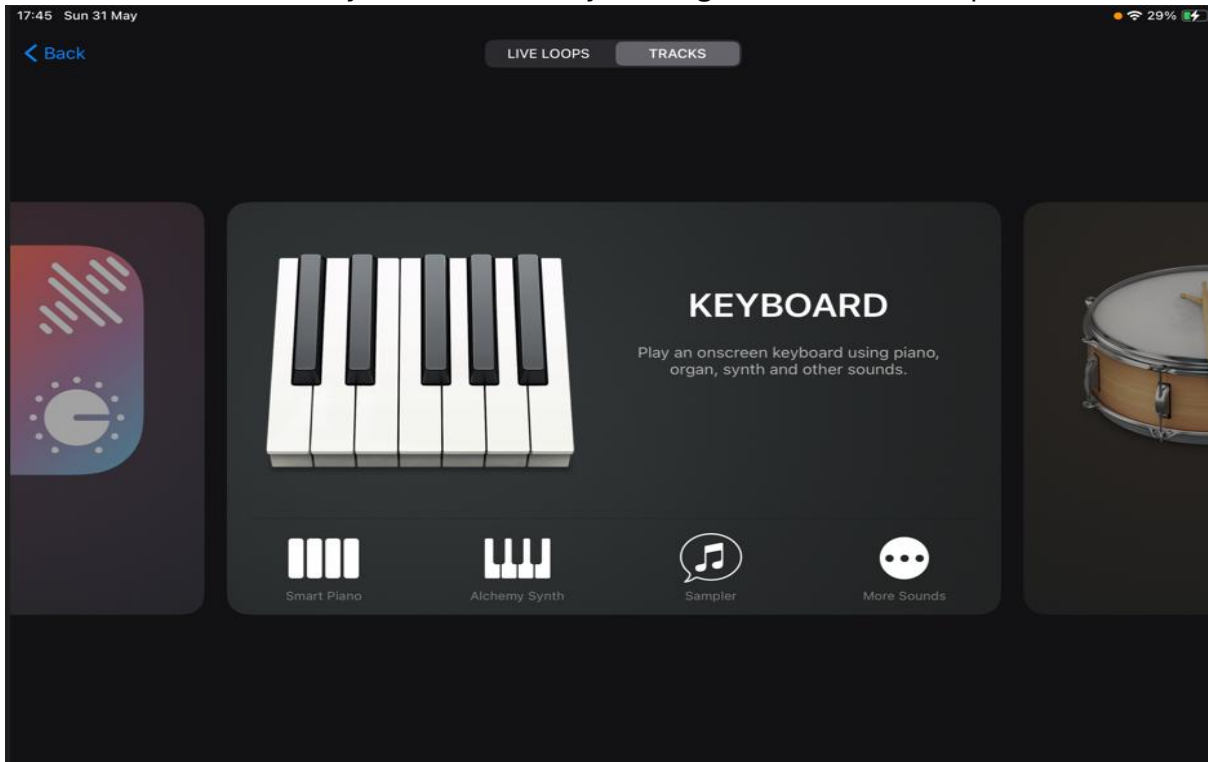

Open your work and go to the tracks icon which takes you to the smart instruments using these two steps.

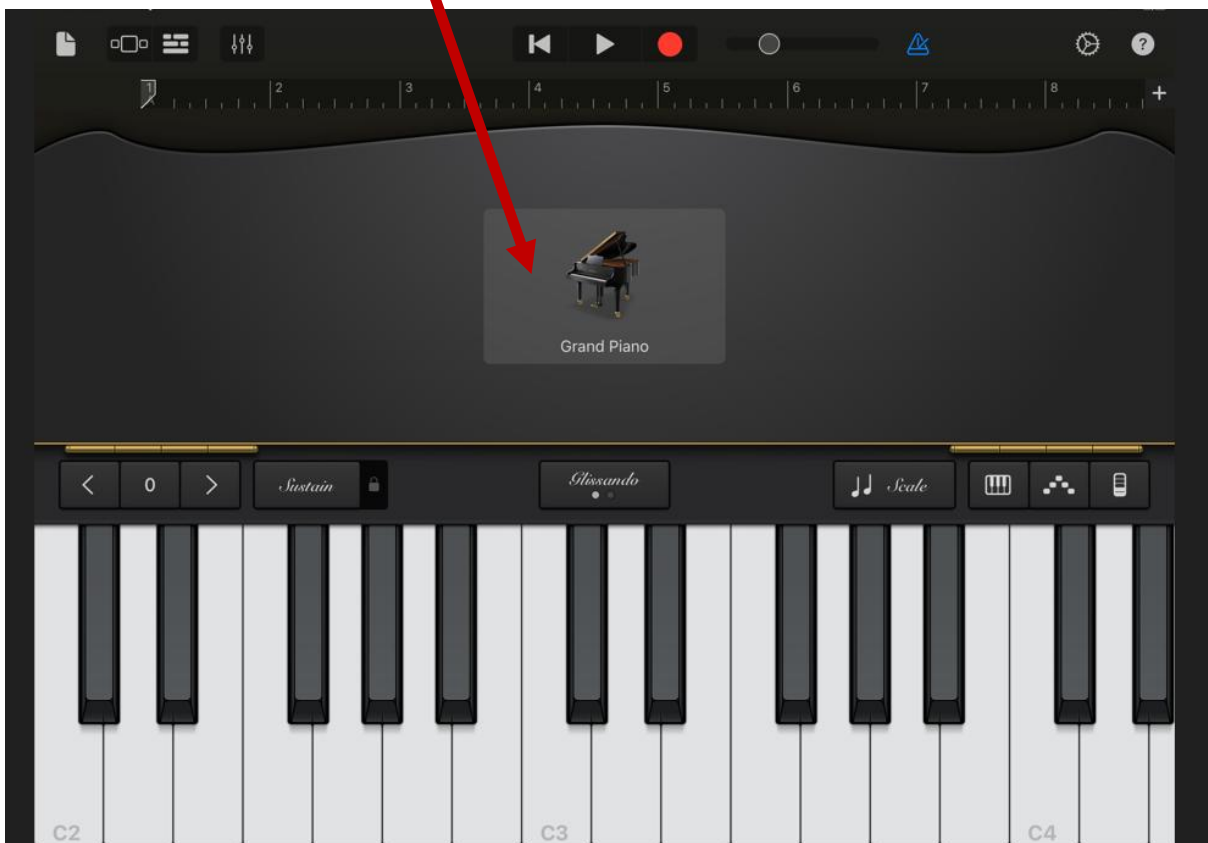


MUSIC MAESTRO PRIMARY

Select which instrument you want to use by clicking on the instrument picture.

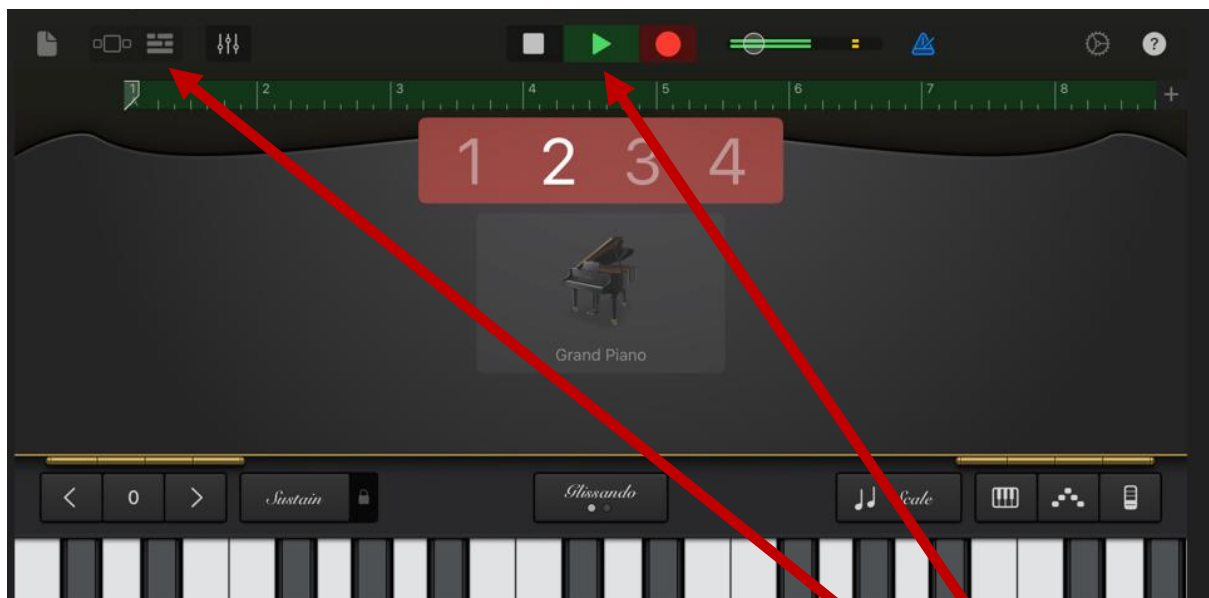


You can change the style of instrument within the instrument page.



MUSIC MAESTRO PRIMARY

Once you are happy with your melody, you can record it over the loop. Push the red record button and you will be given a 4-beat count in. Don't forget to go back to the beginning before you push record.

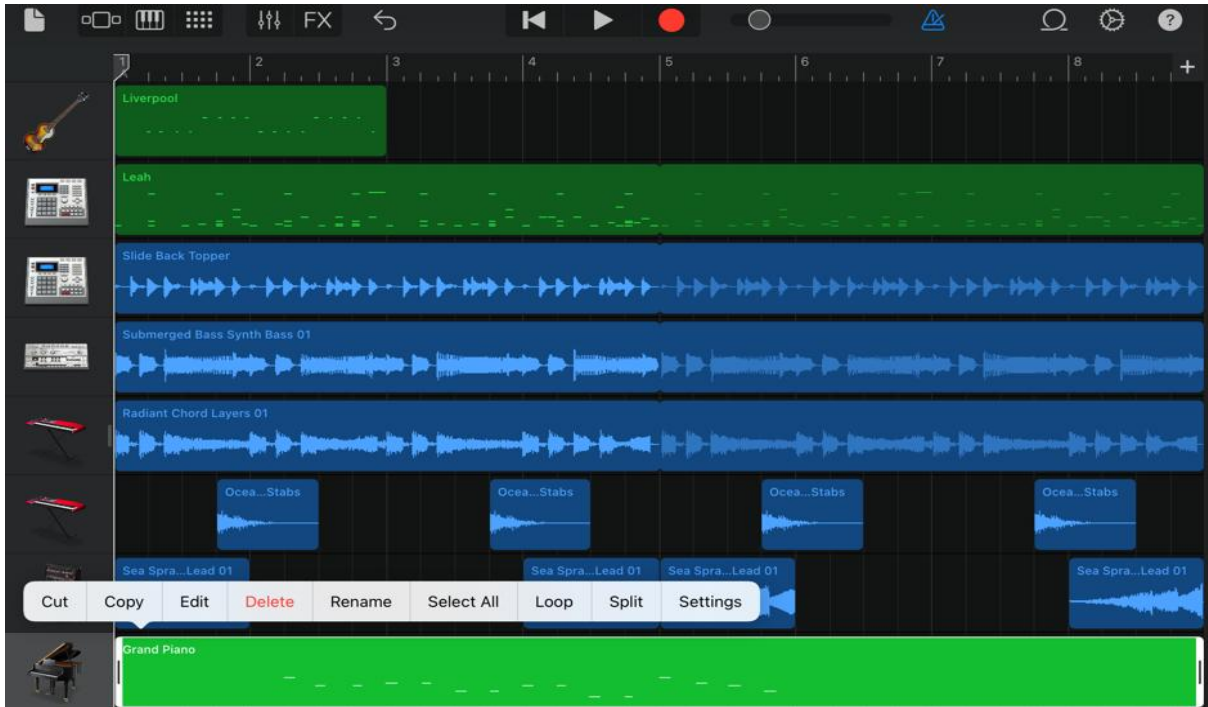


Once you have recorded this, you can listen to it by pushing the triangle play button.

If you are not happy with it and wish to delete and start again, press the track button to see all your recorded tracks.

To delete any tracks you are not happy with, click on the one you want to delete and the text box should appear. Click 'delete' and the track should vanish from the track list.

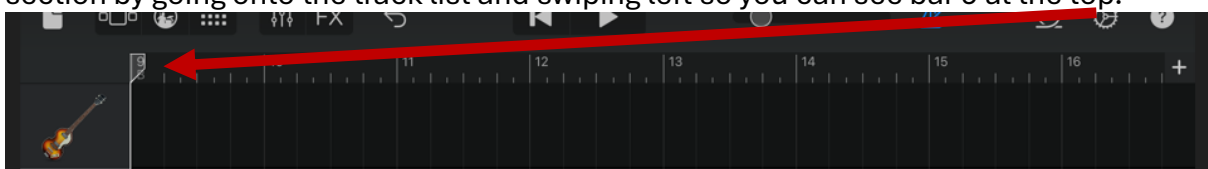


It will leave the instrument picture but will remove the sound, giving you the chance to re-record your melody.



To re-record, follow the steps you used above.

To record your second section melody, first of all make sure you are on the second loop section by going onto the track list and swiping left so you can see bar 9 at the top.

Then go back to your instrument list by clicking here



Record your instrument track as you did previously. Don't forget to go back to the beginning of the section before you record.



When you have completed this, there is one last thing before you are ready to perform your song. In order to make the whole piece play and not just section A or B you need to click on the '+' button in the right corner and highlight 'All Sections'. This will play your piece all the way through.
